What Are the Four Types of Sentences?

- Declarative sentence
- Imperative sentence
- Interrogative sentence
- Exclamatory sentence
 - Declarative sentence- makes a statement or expresses an opinion.
 "I want to be a chef." (make a statement)
 I don't like paintings with dark colors (state an opinion)
 - 2. Imperative sentence- gives a command or makes a request.

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"Leave the room."
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"I need you to finish your work"

3. Interrogative sentence - asks a question, often begins with who, what, where, when, why, how, or do, and it ends with a question mark.

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"When are you leaving?"
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4. Exclamatory sentence- expresses great emotion such as excitement, surprise, happiness and anger, and ends with an exclamation point.

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"It is such a lovely day!"




