The students who got 575 distinctions in various subjects made the school swelled with pride. Not only in class 12th, even the tenthies of the school did remarkably well in their boards. 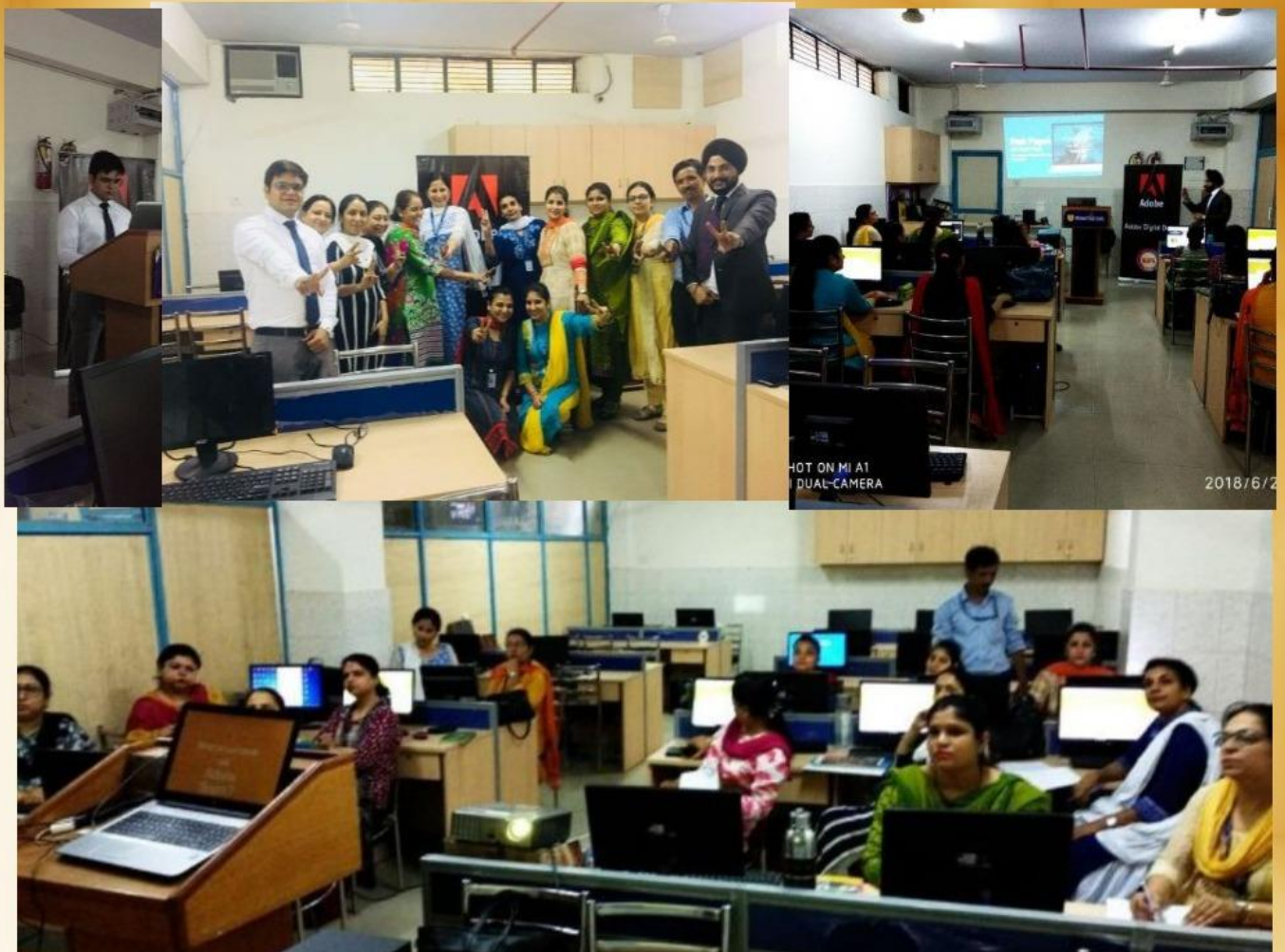


# WORKSHOP ON “ADOBE DIGITAL DISHA PROGRAM BY KIPS ”
