CIRCULAR

Sub.: Organizing Teaching Learning Activities for the Students during the Lockdown Period

In pursuance of orders issued by the Health and Family Welfare Department, GNCTD regarding the suspension of classes in schools due to the spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) pandemic, the formal academic activities cannot commence w.e.f. April 1, 2020. However, in order to minimize the academic loss of students, the Directorate of Education, Government of NCT Delhi has made an elaborate plan to resume teaching learning activities for the students of schools run and aided by the Directorate of Education through remote means.

The plans are as follows:

- 1. For Students of KG- Class VIII: All parents will receive daily activities (reading, writing, doing, thinking, and speaking) via SMS & Interactive Voice Response (IVRs.) Students will do these simple activities on their own or with the help of parents and siblings. They will record it in students' notebooks for the purpose of Internal Assessments when the schools reopen. All teachers are directed to stay in regular touch with the students who they taught during the academic session 2019-20 and guide them through phone.
- 2. Live (online) classes shall be conducted for students who appeared in class XI exams and are awaiting the results. These classes shall be conducted by shortlisted teachers of Delhi Government schools using online platform. These teachers have already been intimated about their assignments. Live online classes will begin in the first week of April. After sometime, similar classes will also be started for class 10th students. If required, classes will also be broadcast on TV, later.
- 3. IT branch will send SMS to the students of class XI in phased manner with a registration link. The students who register and join the live classes regularly will receive Rs. 200 towards data package cost through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT), later.
- 4. Further plan for Classes IX, X and XI will be decided after consulting about the same with CBSE.

In addition, Worksheets for classes I and II, Pragati Books for classes VI to VIII and Support Material for classes IX to XII are already available online on the website of Directorate of Education (Edu Del).HoSs must guide the students of these classes to go through these valuable materials during the lockdown period. Mass SMS facility can be used for this propose.

Apart from these, teachers may also use Teaching Learning Material available through other sources. Refer Annexure 1 for more details.

Apart from students, all the HOS are directed to inform the parents and teachers also (through digital platform/telephonic message/ mass SMS facility etc) to motivate students to utilize these valuable resources/support material. And maintain a daily record of the activities/assignments (upto Class VIII) which will further be used as the portfolios for their Internal Assessment in the new session 2020-21.
