Oh dear Dishi, I have to continue my astronomy homework also, so meet you tomorrow.

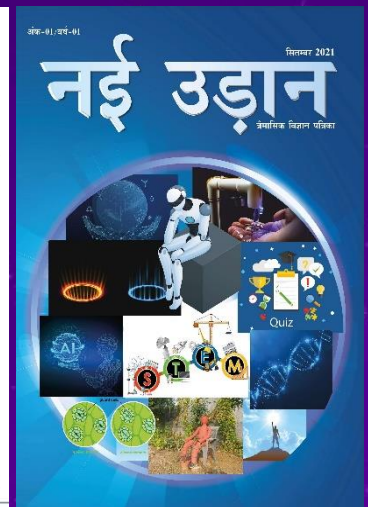
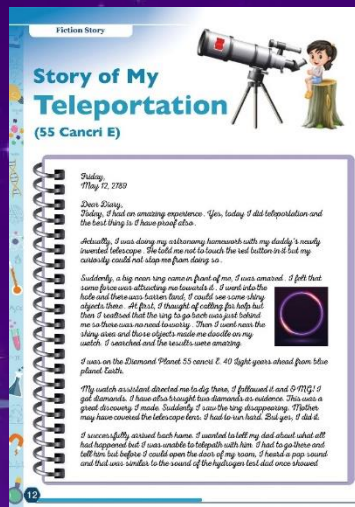

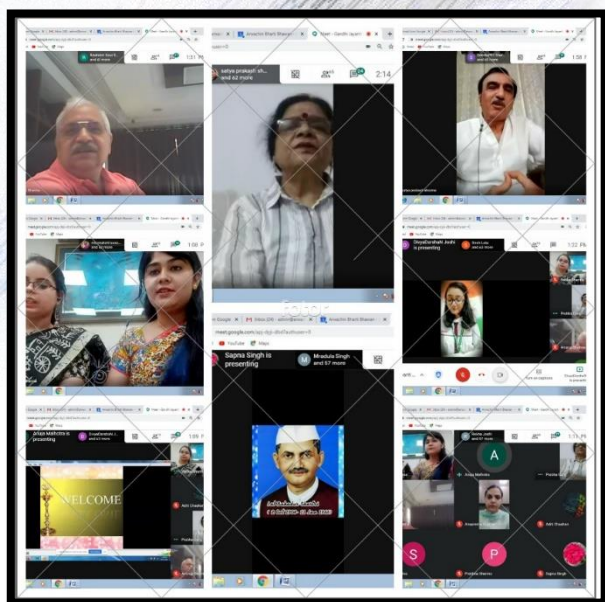
CELEBRATING 150TH BIRTH ANNIVERSARY OF MAHATMA GANDHI

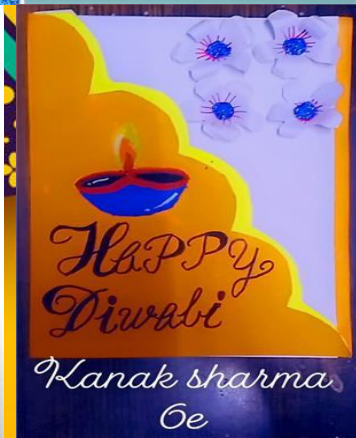
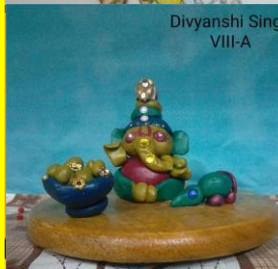
TEEJ MEHNDI

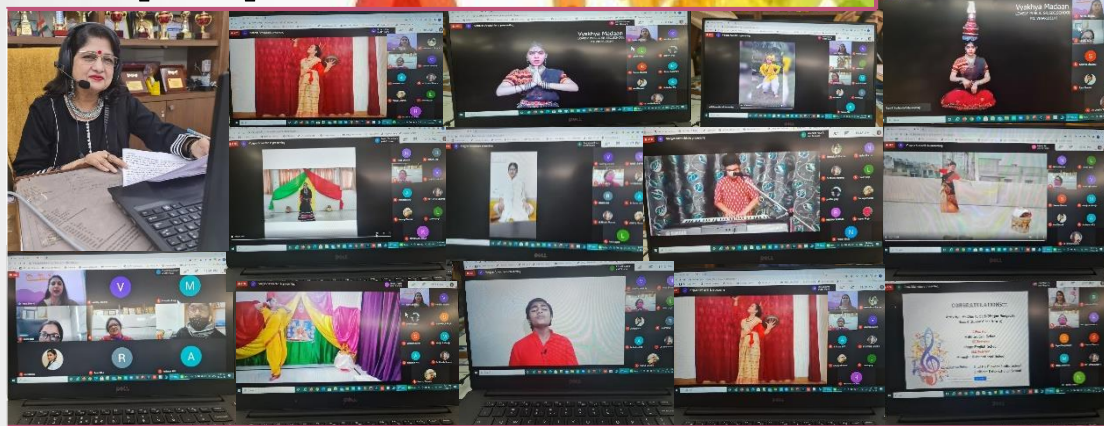

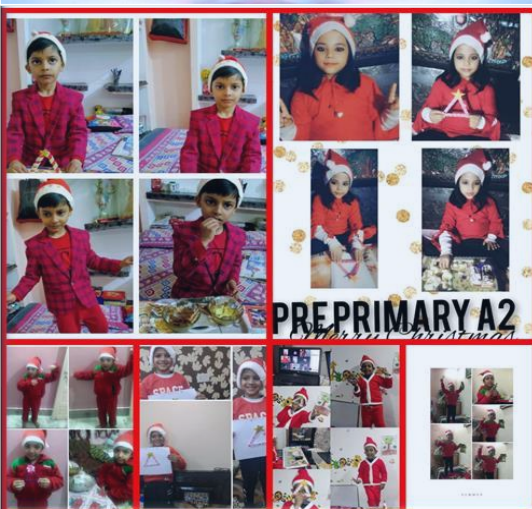


EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT



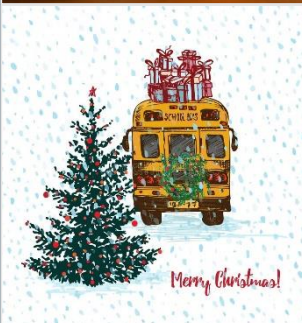

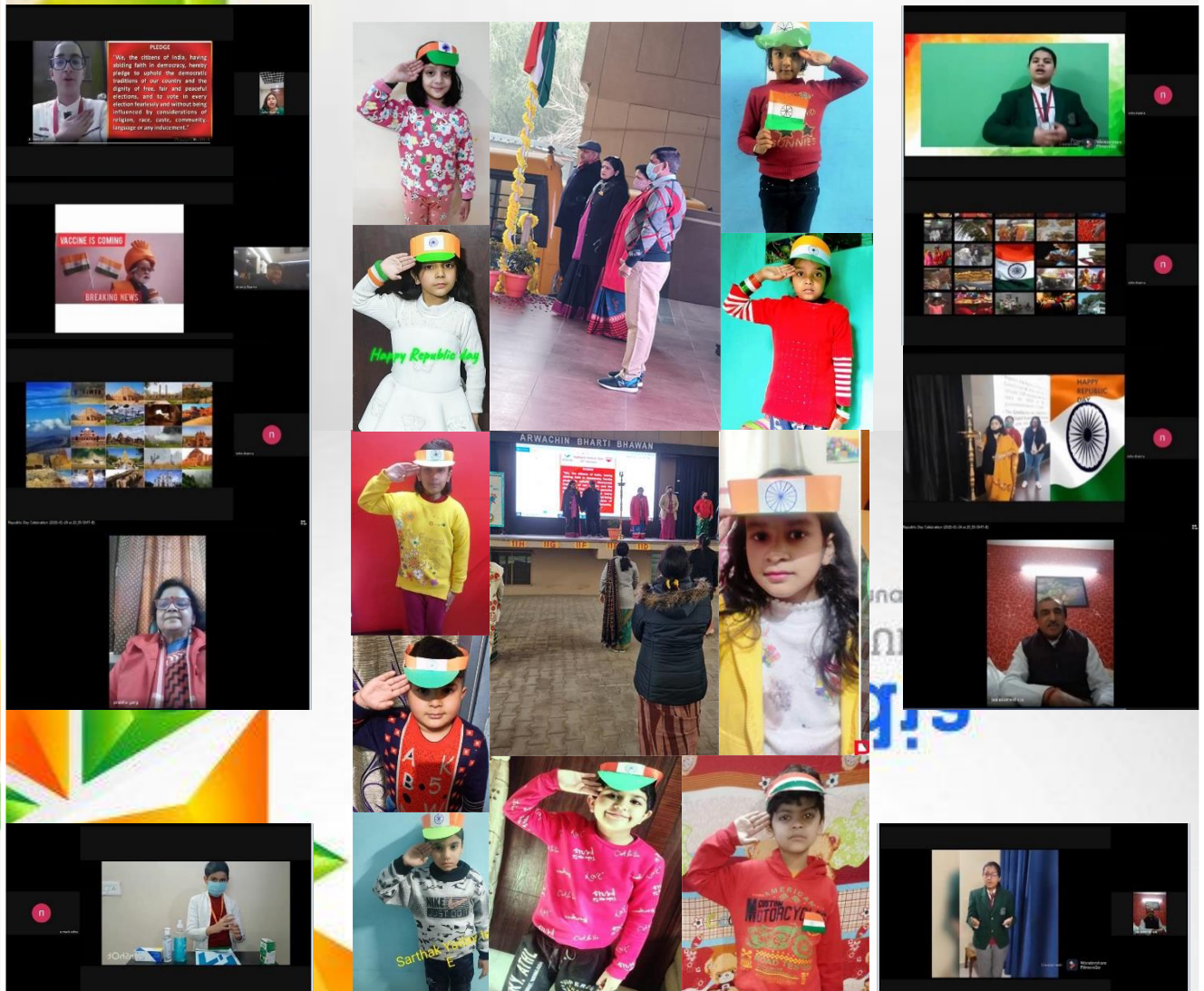
