participants showcased their singing talent followed by solo dance show by the middle wing students.


The students and their parents spend some time together and enjoyed the activities. The stalls put up by students of Stem Club was a crowd puller.


### Robotics, Astronomy, Smart Electronics and Renewable Energy






#### Visit to Rail Museum






# **Educational Excursion to Agra**

#### SEMINARS/WORKSHOPS




