



Glimpse of the Workshop

- To prepare children to recognize and respond effectively to early bullying behavior.
- To create an environment where everyone understands that bullying behaviors are unacceptable, harmful and preventable
- To understand the extent, seriousness and dynamics of bullying

A virtual workshop on anti-bullying was organized by MBS International School for the students of Grade IV and V on July 04,2020.

Bullying is unwanted, aggressive behavior among school aged children that involves a real or perceived power imbalance. The behavior is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated. Both the children who are bullied and who bully others may have serious, lasting problems. The primary aim of the workshop was to sensitize the students about the different kinds of bullying which are prevalent in our society. To make the workshop more illustrative and visual, multimedia was used to deliver a power point presentation on anti- bullying. An in-depth discussion was done about bullying's effect on the victims mental and physical health and the immense contribution of bystanders effect and negligence which empowers the strength of the bully was discussed. It ended with a healthy question answer session wherein the students participated well.
