A four member team including library head and teachers, from MBS International School, visited the British Council, New Delhi on 07.08.2018 for a workshop on 'Changing the Role of our Libraries.' A highly informative session, the workshop aimed at making school libraries a place of activity and learning rather than keeping them a silent zone and fostering interest in children for reading. The resource person, Ms. Meenu stressed upon the need to orient the children towards library rules, terms and different genres of reading, at the beginning of the session. The need to involve parents and a strong cross curriculum link using library books was also emphasized. Extrapolative activities such as author talk, book review, good readers' programme were recommended as was the optimum use of technology to keep pace with the changing times and make reading more enjoyable and fruitful. The workshop concluded with an interactive session wherein challenges faced in the library were discussed and possible ways to overcome them followed by an exchange of ideas.
