A report on the workshop attended by the English teachers on the topic – Challenges on Teaching English.

The workshop started with the discussion on the challenges that the language teachers faced in the classroom with the present curriculum which made the students follow confound- thinking since there are no clear-cut policies.

With less of exposure to the language, students had been continuously encouraged to learn by rote. Creativity had been so bounded among the books that they would not think out of box.

First and foremost thing, we have to develop for learning is to UNLEARN and RELEARN. The twenty first century skills of teaching demands that we have to motivate creativity in the students. Teachers should develop thinking skills of the students by exploring and experimenting new modas operandi. We should ask the students interest-bidding questions in order to encourage critical thinking as it would develop questioning attitude among the learners.
