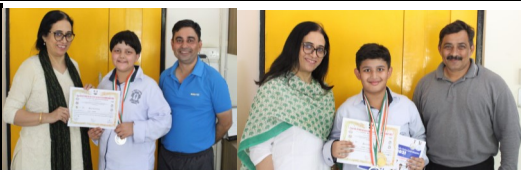

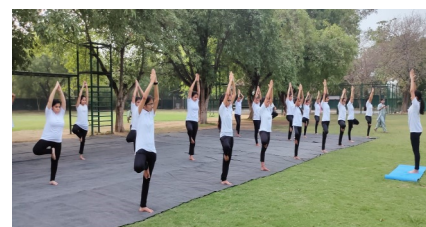


IMPORTANT DAYS
