A webinar was organized by Navjyoti Institute Disabilities and AAROH Teacher Training Center at International Level on the Topic School at Home: Different teaching strategies and Management for Special Educators and Rehabilitation Professionals. Experts from the Rehabilitation field Dr. Prithivi Prepa, Lecturer in Autism, School of Education, University of Birmingham, Edgbaston, Birmingham, United Kingdom, and Dr. Amrapali Lahiri, Occupational Therapist, Expert in sensory Integration therapy, certified Brain gym therapist conducted the webinar.

The webinar aimed at providing teaching strategies to teach students using visual stimuli. Special educators are guided on how to use pictorial representation and prepare the homebound plan. Dr. Amrapali Lahiri guided professionals in preparing homebound programs keeping sensory issues in mind and utilizing things available at home to calm hyperactivity in children. Some of the deep pressure exercises and strategies to improve disturb sleep patterns were also demonstrated using the presentation and discussed with the participants.

Special Educators and rehab professionals were encouraged to work with children with special needs by providing Home Bound plan and guiding parents in conducting therapy sessions at home utilizing things available at home. It was indeed motivating and enriching experience.
