The need to acquaint the students with the required approach to get through the competitive exams was emphasized. They were apprised with the different levels of exams conducted-

- PSA (Problem Solving Assessment) conducted by CBSE for classes 9 & 11.
- JSTSE (Junior Science Talent Search Examination) conducted by Directorate of Education, Delhi for class 9.
- NTSE (National Talent Search Examination) conducted by Directorate of Education (Stage 1) and NCERT (Stage 2). The scheme was started in 1963
- Proficiency Test conducted by CBSE for class 10.
