An interactive session to spread awareness against bullying was conducted by the council body members of class 12th in order to make ITL a truly NO BULLYING ZONE.

The session was conducted in each class separately to tackle the problem from the grass-root level so that the discussion takes place on one-to-one basis.

It was commendable to note that even class 6th students knew the meaning of bullying. The signs and symptoms of bullying, along with the physical and mental trauma caused were discussed with the students and thus, sensitivity was generated. Though some students were hesitant to answer if they were bullied, many told by whom they were bullied, as the student council body members made a rapport with the students and assured them that strict action will be taken by them. The aspect of cyber-bullying was also discussed after which, some students accepted to have cyber-bullied others. Drug Abuse was also talked over in class 10th. It will be an on-going process and many follow-ups will be conducted. In all, it was a truly enriching experience for the students and a wonderful initiative to sensitise the students about bullying.
