ITL Public School, Sector- 9, Dwarka, New Delhi launched a two week long celebration of its 'Mega Cleanliness Drive' –GREEN WARRIORS from August 1st to 14th, 2017.

The objective of the Cleanliness drive was to sensitize the students about global challenges like environmental degradation, declining rainfall, changing weather patterns etc.

The week commenced with a workshop by 'We Plant' – a non- profit organization which is actively involved in establishing seed banks in schools. The workshop was followed by a plantation drive in the school backyard. Other activities included Installation of vermicomposting unit in the school premises, explaining basic gardening tips to the students by the school gardeners, signature campaign against the excessive use of Aluminum foil, role play on personal hygiene etc. To make the drive against plastics a mass movement, 'Nukkad Nataks' were staged by the students in sec-6 and sec-10 markets of Dwarka. However, the focal point of the Mega Cleanliness Drive was the 'Go Green competition', an interclass competition for preparation of herbal products like lotion, cream, shampoos, scrubs, masks, lip balms etc. The best amongst these will be chosen as products to be launched under the brand name 'Anthelia' for the year 2017.
