A Creative Writing Workshop was held at ITL Public School on 4 May, 2018 for the students of Classes VI to IX to honour the World Book Day. The esteemed resource person for the event was Ms Sreerupa Sil, the former Editor of BW Business World. Ms Sreerupa in her numerous articles presented her valuable opinions and reflections on the present educational trends in India. Ms Sreerupa discussed in full length the essence of Creative Writing which aims at expressing thoughts, feelings or emotions by the use of right vocabulary and expressions. The interactive workshop started with a warming up session wherein the students were divided into groups. Each group was asked to choose a word and related to that word they were asked to write continuously in a flow for 3 minutes without pausing to think, thus making students understand the features of a first draft. Ms Sreerupa in an interesting manner graphically explained how the five W's i.e Who, What, When, Where, Why and one H-i.e. How are quintessential for creating a good piece of creative writing. The students learnt that some of the traits of a good writer comprise of selfreviewing, researching, organizing ideas, brainstorming, etc. The students could understand that the crux of creative writing is to select an idea, narrow the idea, and elaborate the idea and to discover the best. The workshop gave a wonderful platform to the students to delve into the pleasures of writing and fantasy. The workshop saw the lively and enthusiastic participation of students excited and empowered with the newly gained knowledge of creative writing.
