An expert session on Criminal Law was conducted by Inspector Bhupesh Kumar, Additional S.H.O. of Pashchim Vihar (East) Police Station on 17th May, 2019. With an experience of over 22 years in criminal investigation, Inspector Bhupesh Kumar, explained in detail how an investigation is done when a cognizable offence takes place. Throwing light on nuances of filing an FIR, Bailable and Non Bailable offences and role of police in gathering evidences, he threw light on the actual working of the Police.

Students could truly go beyond the textbook when he shared his experiences from various cases that he had handled over the years. A study of two chargesheets that he had brought along with him was a true learning experience for the ITLeens. Speaking at length about 'White Collar Crimes' and 'Crimes against person and property', he lucidly differentiated between types of offences and the rights and duties of a police officer in Criminal procedure.
