The department of Social Science organized a series of activities during the Disaster Management Week "Command over Calamity"

The event aimed at inspiring the students to do an in depth research on various Natural and Manmade Disasters. Students of classes VI- XII participated in various activities organized during the week which equipped the students to deal with such situations.

On the first day of the week, the students prepared wonderful e-posters and pamphlets depicting various mitigation strategies that could be taken up during any natural disasters.

On the second day of the week, a workshop on usage of safety devices during manmade disasters was conducted to give hands on experience to the students on acquiring the skills of handling different types of fire extinguishers and water pipes that are commonly used in case of fire.

On the third day a Panel Discussion on Industrial disasters was organized, where the students discussed about different industrial disasters that were mostly caused due to human negligence and came out with different strategies that can be followed to reduce the risk in the industries.

The department also organized a TED talk on "Disaster Preparedness". The speaker of the session was Mr. Rajpal Takhar, Inspector, NDRF (National Disaster Response Force). The resource person shared his practical experiences as a member of Rescue Force and explained to the students the importance of training to deal with such adverse situation more effectively. The most significant part of the workshop was the demonstration given by the members of NDRF regarding various First Aid and life saving techniques that can be followed in case of any Natural or Manmade disasters.
