Classes VI-VIII showed their creative skills with Book Mark, Extempore on Accept not Expect, Role Play on ensuring different Human Rights...

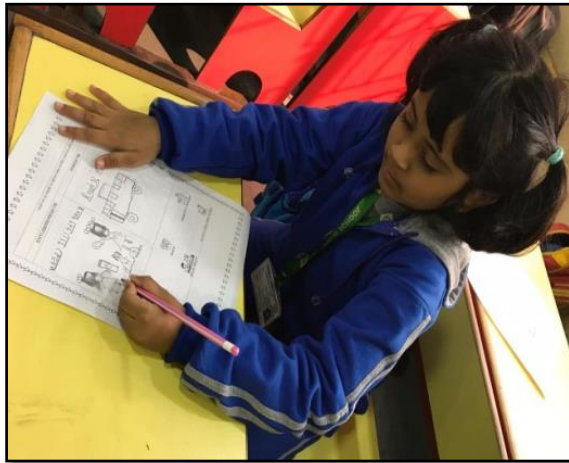

With the Human Rights Week, ITL seeks to take the first step in the direction to inspire young minds to work for a better and sustainable world.



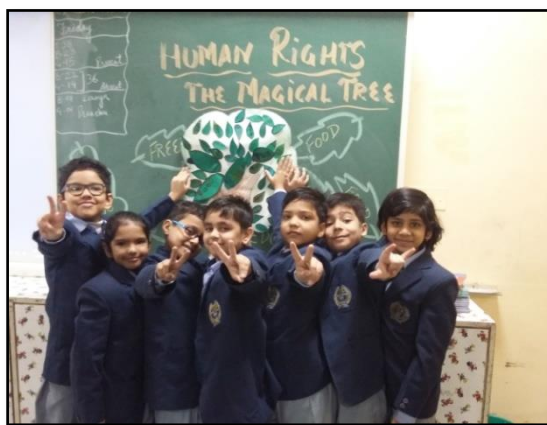
