



Report on Odd Even Activity

Topic: Odd and Even Activity

Date- 6th May, 2020

Class: II

To make the concept of Odd and Even numbers more interesting, an activity with match sticks was done by Class II on 6th May 2020.

Students were told at the beginning of the activity that

- **Odd numbers ends with 1,3, 5, 7, 9**
- **Even numbers ends with 0, 2, 4, 6, 8**
- **Even number always make pair**

Students were asked to take 8 matchsticks and arrange them in pairs. Students pasted them on an A4 size sheet. Match sticks were equally divided .Therefore 8 is an even number.

Then students were asked to take 9 match sticks. They arranged the sticks in pair but one stick was left without pair. Therefore 9 is an odd number.

By doing this activity children easily came to know the concept of Odd and Even numbers. Children were also asked to take two digit numbers. The representation of the numbers on match sticks helped the students in finding out odd and even numbers. Students enjoyed this activity very much.
