Engage Model Lesson Plan stressed on Competency Based Education with focus on acquisition of Skills through Meta Learning. Engage Model Lesson Plan is highly beneficial for students where E Stands for Energize, N for Navigate, G for Generate, A for Apply G for Gauge, and E for Extend . The School Principal Dr Sudha Acharya cordially welcomed the Resource person and felicitated him with a planter.

With the implementation of **NEP 2020** the school curricula and pedagogy aimed for holistic development of learners by equipping them with the key 21st century skills, reduction in curricular content to enhance essential learning and critical thinking and greater focus on experiential learning. The Resource Person highlighted adequately that in order to meet the salient features of **NEP** there is a need for conspicuous shift from **What to Learn** to **How to Learn**. In the new system the teachers have the great responsibility **to inspire students to aspire**. The workshop made the teachers realize that students need to acquire knowledge, skill, competency apart from having the capacity of self-assessment and self-evaluation

The Learning Objectives of the Teacher Driven Learning should be from LOT to HOT, it should be S.M.A.R.T, that is, it should be Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relatable and Time Bound. The Student Driven Learning should be based on Meta-Learning whereby learning is visible, shareable and amplifiable. Entry Card and Exit Card as part of Student Portfolio was quite a unique and novel concept. Mr Abhishek from Voice of Choice engaged the teachers in a number of interesting activities. His presentation on Vata, Pitta and Kapha children and how to bring out the best in them was quite enlightening and informative.

The CBE Based Lesson Plan empowered teachers to set Higher Order Thinking objectives, thus strengthening Teaching Learning process and imparting 21st century Skills to students The session was a great learning experience for teachers.
