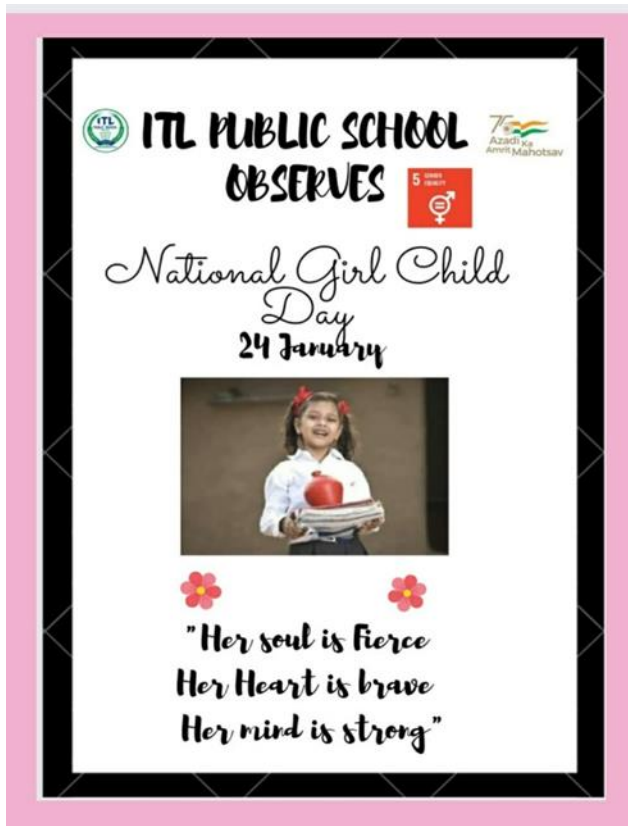




Report on National Girl Child Day
