The bicycle contributes to cleaner air and less congestion and makes education, health care and other social services more accessible to the most vulnerable populations.</p> <p>➤ <u>Brief description of the activity-</u></p> <p>In April 2018, the United Nations General Assembly declared June 3 as International World Bicycle Day. The resolution for World Bicycle Day recognizes "the uniqueness, longevity and versatility of the bicycle, which has been in use for two centuries, and that it is a simple, affordable, reliable, clean and environmentally fit sustainable means of transport."</p> <p>An awareness poster was shared with the students visualizing about the importance, theme, steps and sustainable development Goals associated with World Bicycle Day. Students were oriented to draw attention to the benefits of using the bicycle. A sustainable transport system that promotes economic growth, reduces inequalities while bolstering the fight against climate change is critical to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals.</p>
