A self help group is a marvellous example of micro credit in India, whose importance is rising in both urban and rural areas. States like UP, Bihar and Madhya Pradesh constitute hundreds of them to organise rural credit and create employment opportunities. The SHG members constructed an engrossing game on the sources of credit. A group of students represented themselves as NBFCs to highlight the importance of these institutions as they have expanded so much over the years and are an important source of credit.

The stock market was the spotlight of the day with students across all classes visiting it to learn the actual dynamics of shares. The student representatives explained how to operate a Demat account and the meaning of various terms like Nifty and shares. The cherry on the cake was the mock stock game that was enjoyed thoroughly by the students and the teachers alike.

The students got even more enthusiastic due to the presence of financial games which made them use their presence of mind on the consumption and saving decisions.
