

Teach India -School Chapter

The Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) team of the Times of India in collaboration with **British Council** organized the **Teach India** –**School Chapter** and took on board the ITL Public School to expand their reach to a larger section of the underprivileged and promoting the concept of volunteerism among the student community. Since April 2014 the school has held two programmes of Teach India – School Chapter.

The interested students were briefed on the programme by means of a presentation so that they could make an informed decision on their involvement in the same.

The CSR team, on the basis of an interview, selected 9 students in each programme for 3 segments. 4 students for Spoken English, 3 students for Community Mobilization and 2 students for the outreach segment were selected by the CSR team.

The two programmes that the student volunteers attended and conducted provided them with hands-on experience at the grass root level, gaining an insight on the problems and issues prevailing in the underserved sections of the society. Through the programme the student volunteers were able to create awareness among the target learners about Teach India Spoken English Programme so that they could become a part of the same in order to facilitate their economic and social upliftment.
