Recycling paper conserves natural resources, saves energy, reduces greenhouse gas emissions, and keeps landfill space free for other types of trash that can't be recycled. Recycling one ton of paper can save 17 trees, 7,000 gallons of water, 380 gallons of oil, 3.3 cubic yards of landfill space and 4,000 kilowatts of energy and reduce greenhouse gas emissions by one metric ton of carbon equivalent (MTCE).

Paper recycling pertains to the processes of reprocessing waste paper for reuse. Paper is one material that can be easily recycled. People need to take their time and save the paper products so that they can be recycled.

On 29th July 2016 the members of the Eco Club of the school worked on this very principle and were successful in converting a fraction of the schools' paper waste into beautiful handmade sheets. This initiative was only made successful due to the constant guidance from Principal of ITL Public School Ms. Sudha Acharya.
