<u>8 August 2016</u> - Day 1 of Mega Cleanliness Drive at ITL Public School, Dwarka ,New Delhi the Students of Environmental Club- Anthelia were enthusiastically involved in Paper Recycling by using waste paper of the school and turning it into beautiful, multi-coloured hand-made sheets. "Zero Garbage concept" was introduced in the school by installing waste bins for Biodegradable and Non - Biodegradable waste.

An online digital Poster Making Competition was conducted for Senior students on the Topic" Swachhata Tann, Mann Aur Vicharo Ki ....."

The best entries were selected and awarded. Students from the whole school took up the issue of cleanliness to sensitize the people in their surroundings.



<u>9 August 2016</u> - Day 2 The members of the Environmental Club of the school- "Anthelia" prepared Herbal Hand Sanitizer in the school premises using pure Aloevera Gel Extract, Rose Water and some essential Herbal Oils. The school Principal, Ms. Sudha Acharya graced the event with her presence and also launched the product. The members of Environmental Council were also given a demo on the process of vermicomposting by a professional. They learnt about the types of waste- biodegradable and

non-biodegradable. They also felt the earthworms in their hands and together pledged to take care of them.



<u>10 August 2016</u> – Day 3 An Ayurveda Herbal Garden christened as 'Sanjivani Vatika' was inaugurated in the school premises by the school Principal, Ms.Sudha Acharya. Students planted saplings of herbal plants such as Ajwain, Lemon grass, Aloe Vera, Tulsi, Curry Leaves (Murraya Sp.), Jatropha, Hibiscus(China Rose), Kalanchoe, Pinnata, Bougainvillea, Alpinea, Neem etc.



11 August 2016 - Day 4 went for a Mega Cleanliness drive to the major market areas of Sector-6 & Sector-10, Dwarka. The students staged a small skit on the topic "Swachh Bharat, Svatantra Bharat" in order to sensitize the masses. Even students cleaned the dirty area using brooms, picked the garbage thrown and segregated it into bins to sensitize the surrounding people. This small effort was greatly appreciated by the crowd of people present there. This type of motivation must be continued to inculcate the values of hygiene and cleanliness in the citizens.
