The enthusiastic students got into the school buses on the morning of 19 Dec'15 for a heritage walk to Qutub Complex which was organised for class V students in collaboration with ITIHAAS.

The students learnt that Delhi was popularly known as Lalkot, when Mohammed Gauri came here from Persia. In 1200 CE, Qutub-ud-Din Aibak, the founder of the Delhi Sultanate started construction of the Qutub Minar. In 1220, Aibak's successor and son-in-law Iltutmish added three storeys to the tower. They visited the Iron Pillar of Delhi, Quwwat-ul-Islam Mosque, Alai Darwaza, the Tomb of Iltutmish, Alai Minar, Ala-ud-din's Madrasa and Tomb, and the Tomb of Imam Zamin. Various legends were narrated to them. The study tour connected the students to their past and rich heritage in a creative and interactive manner. The students were engaged in various activities like tracing figures of Hindu Gods and Goddesses on the pillars, drawing images etc. All the activities were very well conducted by ITIHAAS.

It was overall an enriching and enjoyable experience for all the students and teachers, which shall remain imprinted in our memories for years to come.
