Emperor Humayun laid the foundations of a city named **Dinpanah or 'Refuge of the Faithful'** here, in 1534, and the inner citadel of this city is the Purana Quila They visited the ruins of fort and the Baoli.

The students were engaged in various activities like tracing figures, telling time with help of shadows etc. All the activities were very well conducted by the ITIHAAS team.
