As a result of this attempt, our enthusiastic students gained immense confidence. The students acquired information on various factors such as origin of a particular festival, methodology of celebrations which included the following:

- Students researched and spoke about the food and Egyptian sweets such as Coctel, Basbousa, Egyptian rice pudding, etc
- When according to the Lunar Calendar are the Egyptian festivals celebrated.
- Students researched about the culture and rituals followed during Sham al –
  Naseem and Ramadan as a result of which they learned about the history and heritage of Egypt.

 Students explained how the Egypt celebrates 'Shemu' their harvest season by offering salted fish and onions to their deities thus celebrating Sham al – Naseem

This created a sense of belongingness and brotherhood which is an essential step towards preparing the students as future global citizens. Along with developing good communications skills, the activityencouraged students to develop respect for the people of different country living in different part of the world following different habits and lifestyle.
