• **SHARING**: The students experience the joy of sharing while doing activities collaboratively. They share their ideas, thoughts and express their views too.




• SOCIAL GRACES: To say "Thank You" when someone does something for them and to say "Please" when they ask for something from someone.

• **DISCIPLINE**: The students will follow self discipline such as maintaining a daily routine, waiting for their turn, giving others a chance to speak etc.



(For example 'Cupboard') for readiness of reading and writing of letters.




