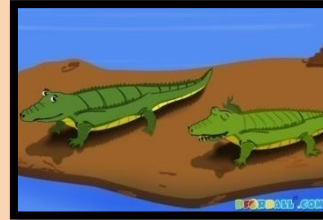


STORY TIME

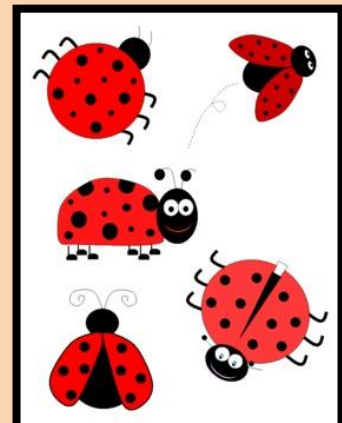

It flew away and then there was none.

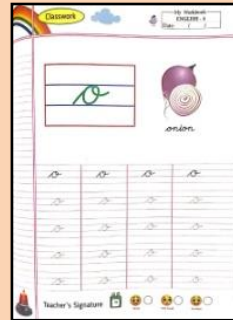

Caring for environment

For e.g.

- They should be motivated to keep the surroundings clean.
- They should plant more and more trees.
- They should adopt a tree or a small park in the nearby park and water the plants daily.
- They should try to conserve water by using various methods.



FOR PARENTS

- Help the child identify and differentiate between cursive and print small letters from any written material.
For example- from newspaper, magazine, etc. Special attention should be given to phonetic sounds.
- To develop reading skills encourage reading of three letter words of vowel 'a' from story books, magazine and newspaper.
