- 3. Let her watch only those programmes on TV which are related to her age group.
- 4. Talk to your daughter about her immediate environment. Help her observe and encourage her to ask more questions.
- 5. Generate her interest in playing some educational games and also play with her.
- 6. Encourage your daughter and help her imbibing some good habits and etiquettes.
- 7. In order to value the importance of cleanliness, few tasks will be shared under the heading "Weekend Cleanliness Task".

  Encourage your daughter to perform these tasks.
- 8. Improve her skills in recognizing objects, show your daughter as many things of different shapes as you can and help her to identify them.
- 9. Motivate your daughter to make cut outs of different shapes, i.e., a circle, square, rectangle and triangle from newspapers and old magazines.
- 10. Encourage your daughter to identify and draw pictures / objects (age appropriate) using as many colours (red, blue, yellow, green, etc) as she can.
- 11. Read a story from any storybook to your daughter every night before putting her to bed.






We hope you and your daughter would enjoy these activities together as we can achieve success only with your unflinching support and cooperation. Stay Home, Stay Safe.


Task 1: Trace each pattern using seven different colours .

Note: Old magazines & newspaper cuttings can be used for the activity.


