
## LISTENING AND SPEAKING SKILLS

Conversation on the Topic "How to take care of plants and the surroundings."


(Students will speak short sentences:- Plants need air, water and sunlight to grow.

Moral: Respect everyone.



# Value Education - Caring towards Nature

Children would learn to water the plants, care for plants and keep their garden/plant area clean.



## Life Skills - Awareness

Students will be learn about the importance of plants, taking care of the environment, not to pluck the flowers and leaves and nurture them with water every day.



## Attitude - Discipline

Children must be encouraged to not pluck flowers and leaves for they too, contain life. This will in turn help them to respect the bounties of nature and help maintain an ecological balance.



## For Parents

• Take the child for Nature walk and show her different types of leaves, flowers, insects and worms that are found in the garden / plant area.





Help the child identify leaves of at least three different common plants (e.g. Tulsi, Neem, Peepal)







- Parents to reinforce pre-number concepts (e.g- big /small, far / near, in/out, empty /full) in daily conversation.
- Please discuss the significance of festivals like Independence Day,
   Janmashtami and Raksha bandhan with your child.
- Show her pictures, videos or in reality the National Emblem, National Bird,
   National Animal and National Flower.
