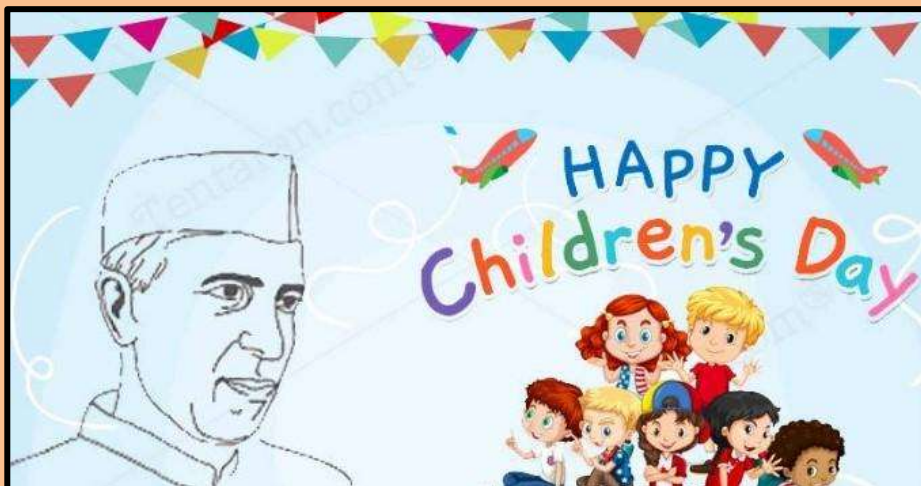
Festivals of the Month

Festivals will be celebrated and their significance will be discussed .

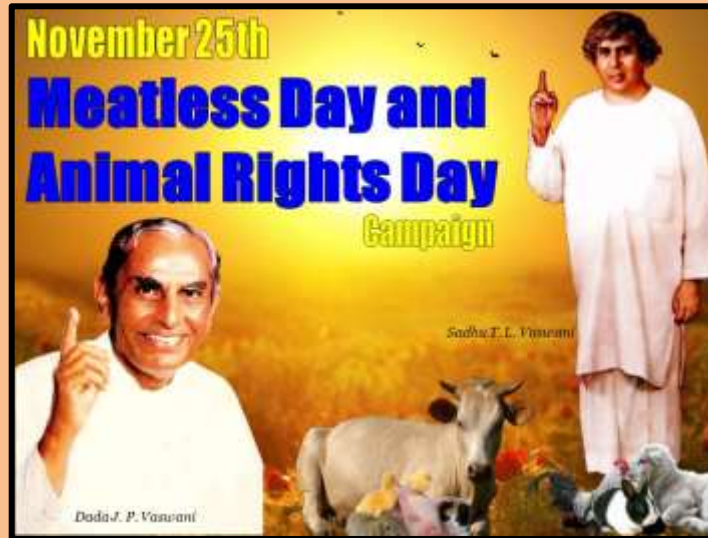
1. Gurpurab (7th November 2022) Children will recite “Mool Mantra” – Ek Onkar

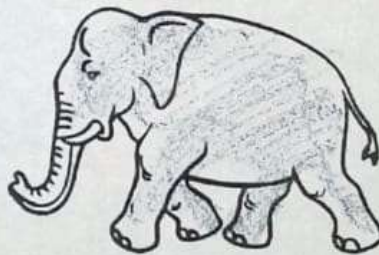
THE ELEPHANT

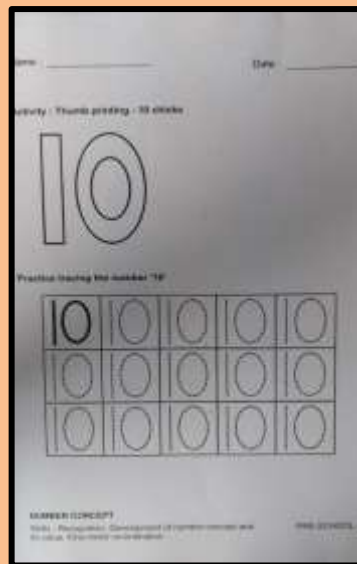
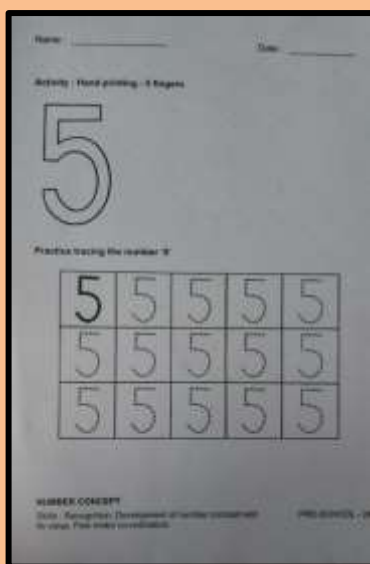

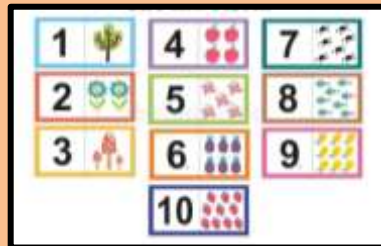
INTER-PERSONAL – SHARING & CARING
