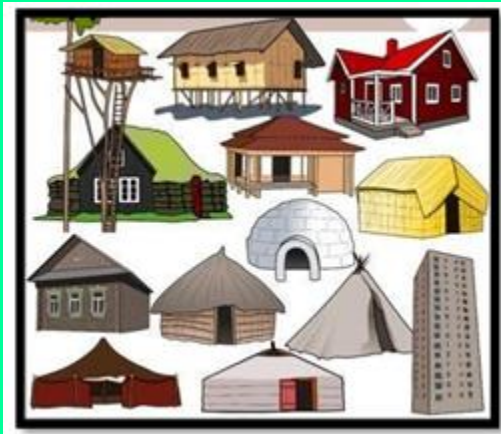

Moral: We should not be lazy

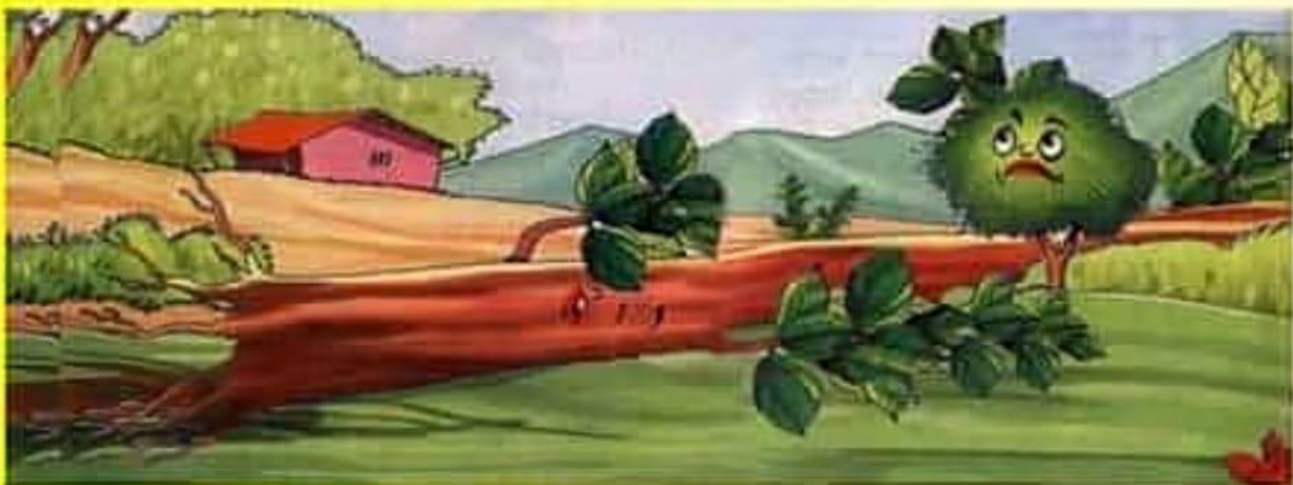
Strong or Weak

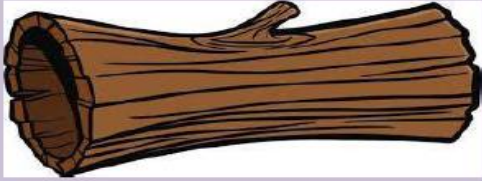

 - Make your child revise three-letter vowel words, sentences and concepts like this-that, and, in or on.
