- 1. Entry inside the Examination Centre (School) - 9:45 am - 10: 45 am**
- 2. Candidates to be in school uniform and carry only Blue/Royal Blue ball point pen, Admit Card, School I-Card & small sanitizer bottle etc. in a transparent pouch**
- 3. Entry inside the Examination room as per the seating arrangement - 10:30 am - 10:45 am**
- 4. No candidate will be allowed to enter after 10:45 am.**
- 5. No candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination centre before the examination is over.**
- 6. Distribution of question papers by Invigilators - 11:00am - 11: 10 am**  
**You are advised to read and follow all the instructions mentioned on the Question Paper and OMR sheet. Esure correct mention of question paper set in OMR and attendance sheet**
- 7. Reading time - 11:10 am - 11:30 am**  
**Reading time of Question Paper will be 20 minutes before the start of examination for all categories of candidates. Candidates are not supposed to write anything on the OMR sheet during reading time. This will be considered as unfair means.**
- 8. Writing time starts at 11:30 am**  
**Duration of Exam - as per time allotted in Question paper**
