- The question paper will consist of:
  - (a) 30% Competency Based Questions. These can be in the form of Multiple Choice Questions, Case based Questions, Source based Integrated Questions or any other type.
  - (b) Objective Type Questions will be 20%
  - (c) Short answer and Long answer questions will be 50%
- Non-examination days are preparatory leaves. Students are not to report to school on non-examination days.
- Sample papers of Mid-Term Examination are uploaded on the School website.
- No after school classes will be conducted from 19/9/2022 to 30/9/2022.
- Dussehra break is from 03/10/2022 to 05/10/2022. School will reopen after Mid term examination and Dussehra break on 06/10/2022. Mid term examination answer sheets will be shown to students on 06/10/2022. Attendance is compulsory on 06/10/2022.
- Parent teacher meeting will be held on Saturday, 15/10/2022 from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm. The Results of the Mid-Term Examination will be declared on the same day.
