Imbibing good moral values such as kindness, humility and compassion at an early age builds a child's character. The formative years help in creating the very core of their being and become a foundation of their moral beliefs. Keeping this in mind, we at ITL Candyfloss School, celebrated Bushel of Ethics and Values Week from 13 – 16 July, 2021. We structured a comprehensive activity plan surrounding on daily activities where we mixed good values with fun elements.

Let us take a look at the activities day wise:

A) MAGICAL WORDS (13th July, 2021):

Good manner is reflected when kids make it a habit to use the magical words in their day-to-day lives. The magical words - Please, Thank You, Welcome, Excuse Me and Sorry - become a part of their vocabulary if we keep using them regularly. On this day, we gave students daily life examples by demonstrating puppet stories to the students.



B) GRATITUDE (14TH July, 2021):

It is said that gratitude is linked to happiness in children which means instilling gratitude in kids at a young age helps them grow up to be happier people. Children learn to express gratitude when they appreciate the things that we usually take for granted. Showing a child gratitude in practice is the most powerful way to reinforce the definition. On this day, the teachers and students together made a gratitude tree by keeping in mind what we are thankful for, on each day.



C) TRUTH and HONESTY (15TH July, 2021):

Honesty is when we speak the truth and also when we act truthfully. Children might think that honesty means not to lie and speaking the truth is a big part of being honest. But honesty means more than not lying, it also encompasses our actions which should equally be

truthful. On this day, students had the best and everlasting experience by hearing moral based stories from our dear Students' Grandmothers/Grandfathers.

D) SHARING (16TH July, 2021):

To share is to spread joy. Sharing is a critical skill that comes in handy when kids play and learn with other kids. It sows the seeds of empathy and helps in building the social skills required for an adult. To inculcate the habit of sharing among the little ones, both teachers and students prepared fruit chaat and shared with their family members, helpers at home and a lesson of Being Caring was taught through animated story shown through screen sharing wherein the children were sensitised towards animals, their needs and protection.
