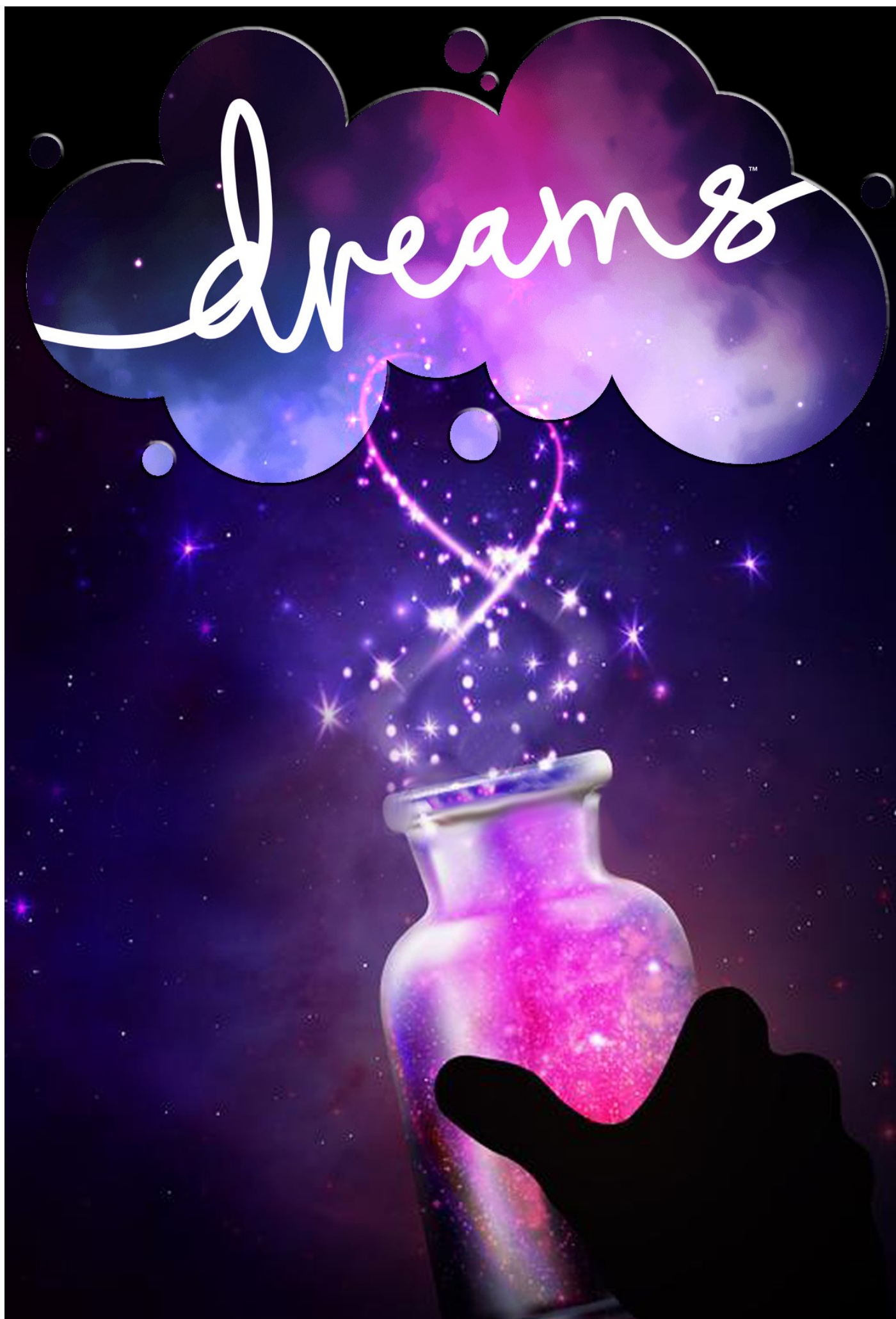

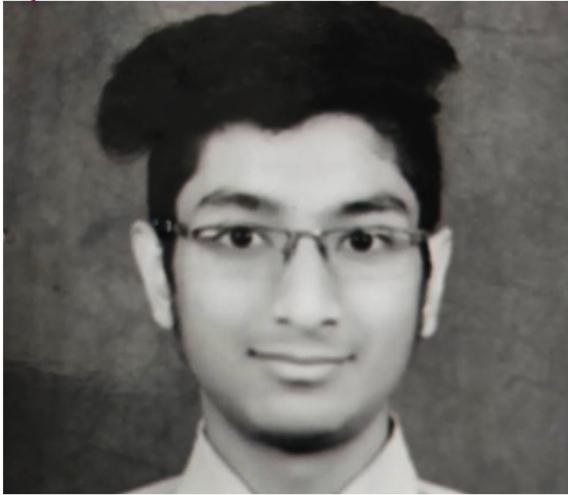
# Dhruvi Khanna

# Arshia Banerjee

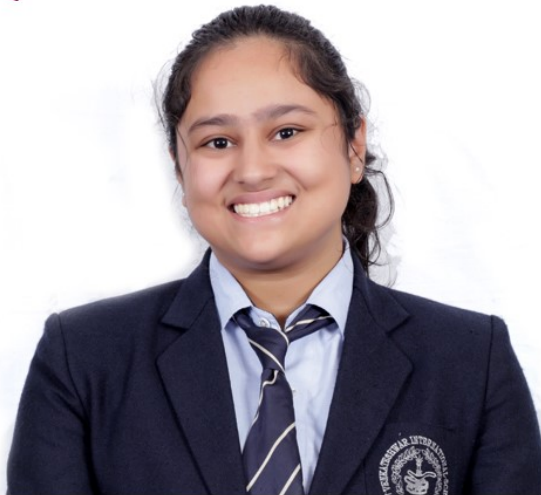

# Navya Nanda

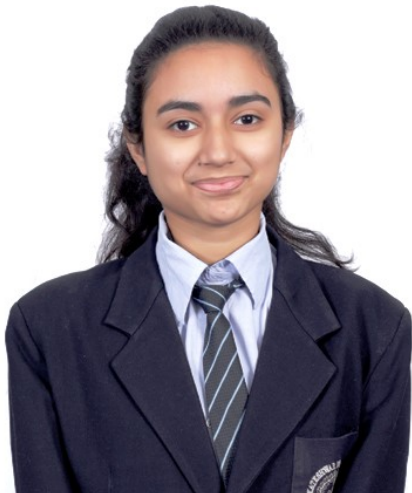
