- 1. Tests will be held online using Microsoft Forms. The form will be uploaded on your wards' Microsoft Team Channel on the day of the exam.
- 2. Test will carry a maximum of 20 marks and will be of 45 minutes duration.
- 3. Test will be live at 8:30 am and will remain live till 9:20 am.
- 4. Your ward is requested to turn in (submit it) not later than 9:20 am.
- 5. For subjective questions, students have the option to either type the answer or write it on a sheet of paper and upload the scanned image of the same. (As per the nature of the question)
- 6. Regular Time Table will be followed after the UT from 9:40 am onwards.
- 7. Test will consist of 2 SUBJECTIVE QUESTIONS OF 3 OR 4 MARKS EACH AND 12 OR 14 OBJECTIVE TYPE QUESTIONS (One word / True-False / Multiple Choice) OF 1 MARK EACH.
- 8. The syllabus for UT2 is uploaded on the School Website and will also be shared by respective subject teachers.
