- **Provide assistance-** There is no better time than this to work together as a community. Let's be sure to help other children and parents who seek help. Also, be aware that the ones not asking for help may be in the most need of it.

Apart from helping our children learn from textbooks, following are a few suggestions that can help them spend the home quarantine time joyfully and productively.

- Value Education- Spend enough time with the family and talk about values that will help them become a better member of the family, society, nation and the world.
- Make the world a smaller place for them- As they (and we) are witnessing the world come together for the first time for a single cause, talk to them about various countries, their flags, their cities, their strengths and challenges, their history etc.

CAUTION- This may result in you learning a lot about the world that you never did earlier in life.




