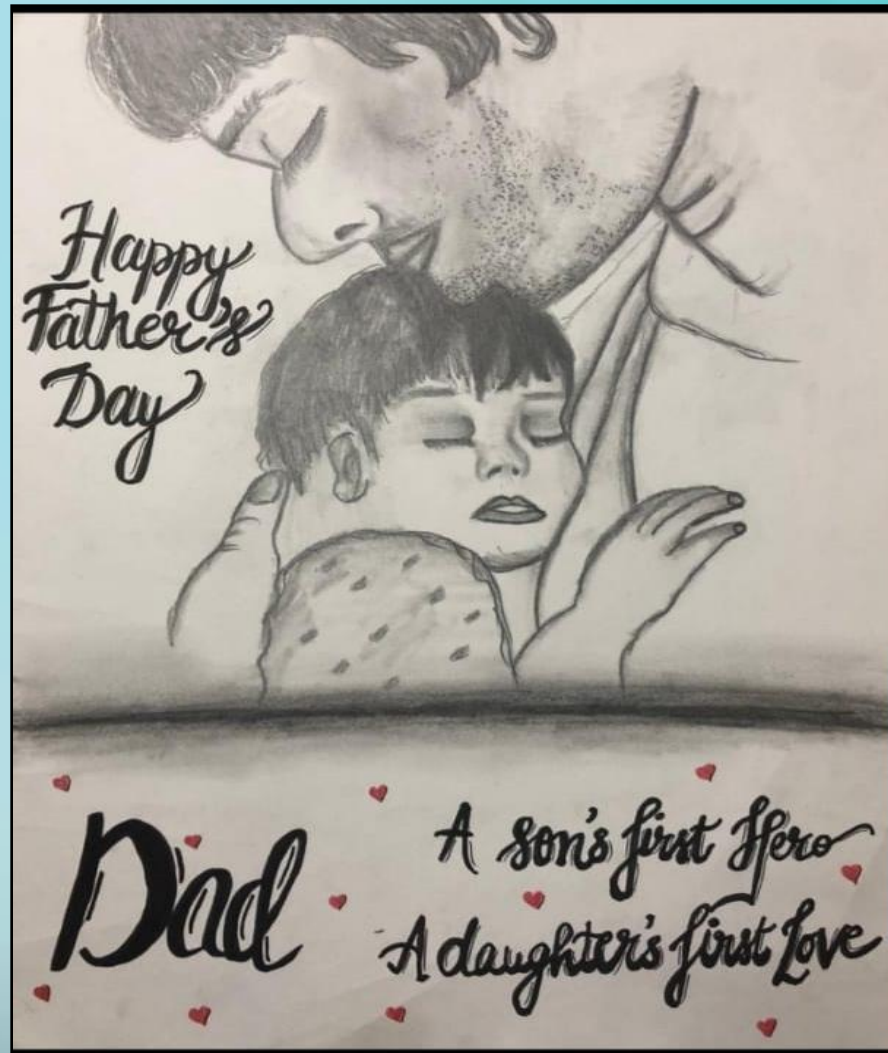

at home, at school, at play.*

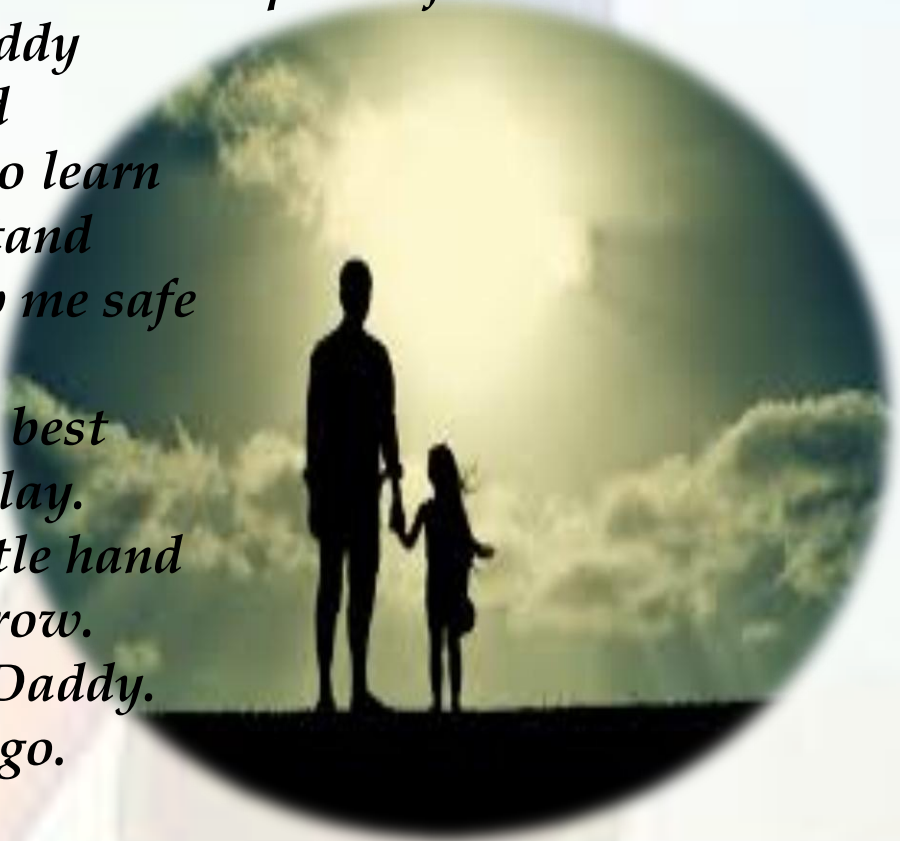
*Every child needs a gentle hand

Best Dad In The World...

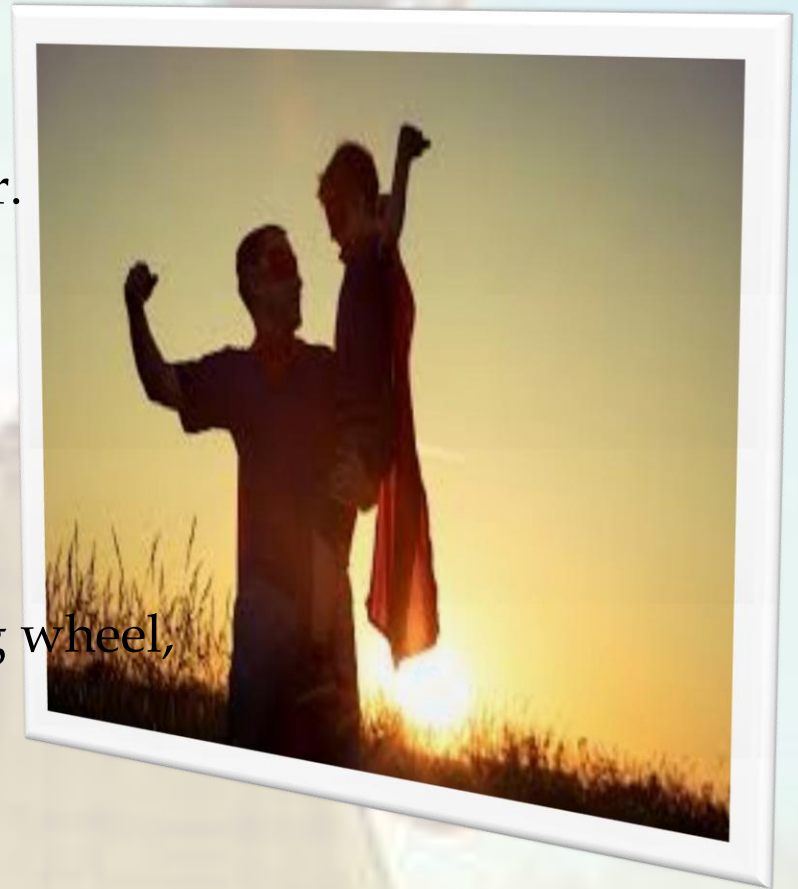
It takes a man to be a warrior,

But he is God to his lovely ones.

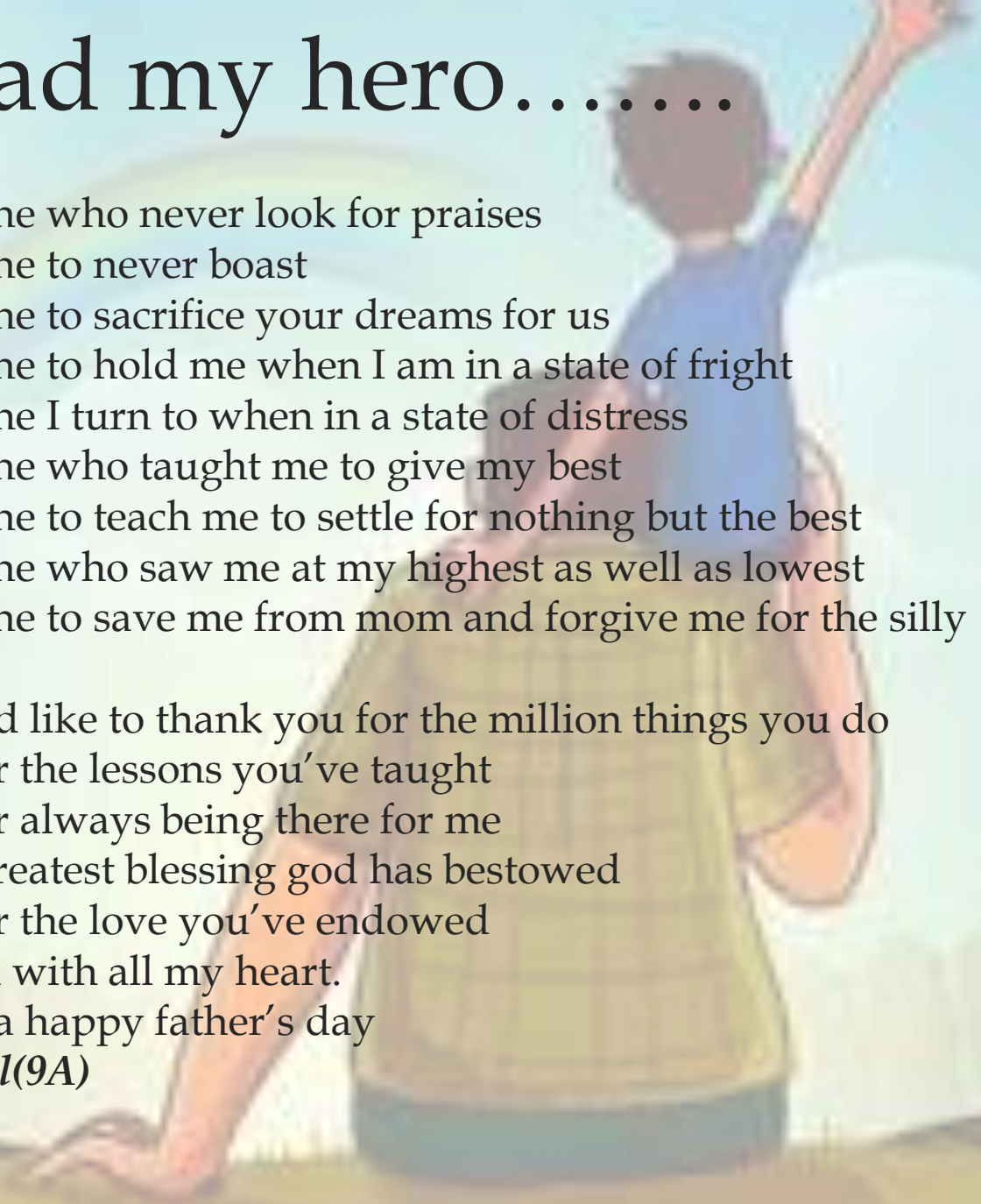

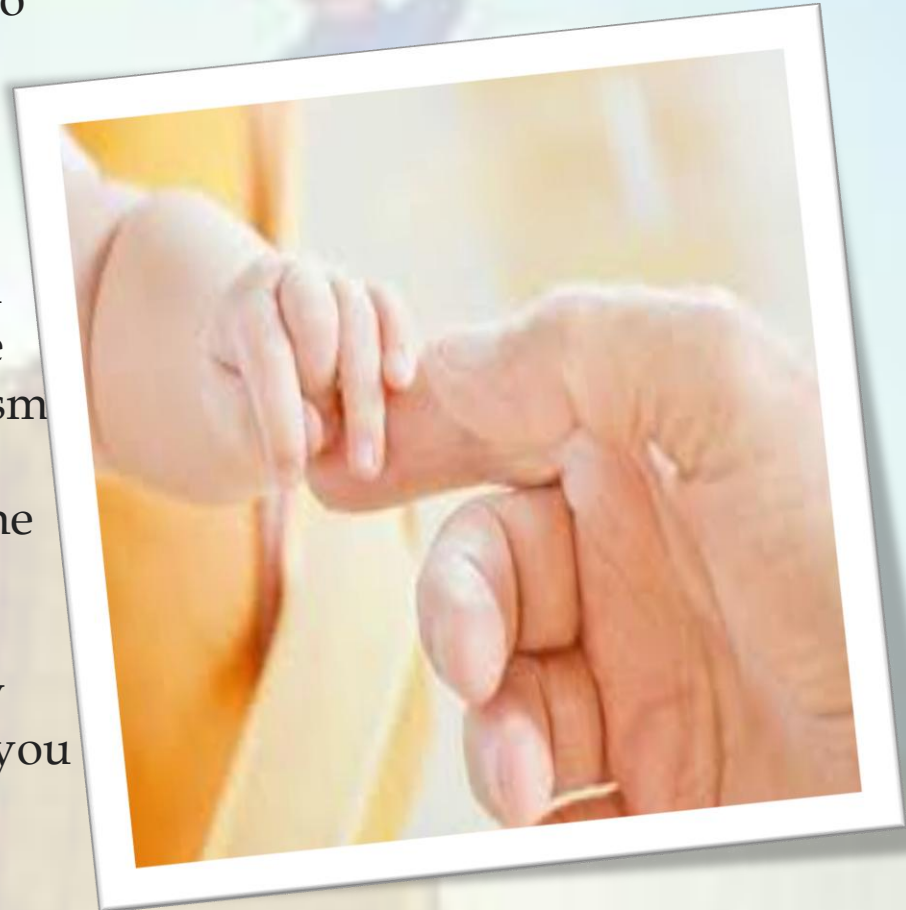

As everyone tells me, I am your mirror image,

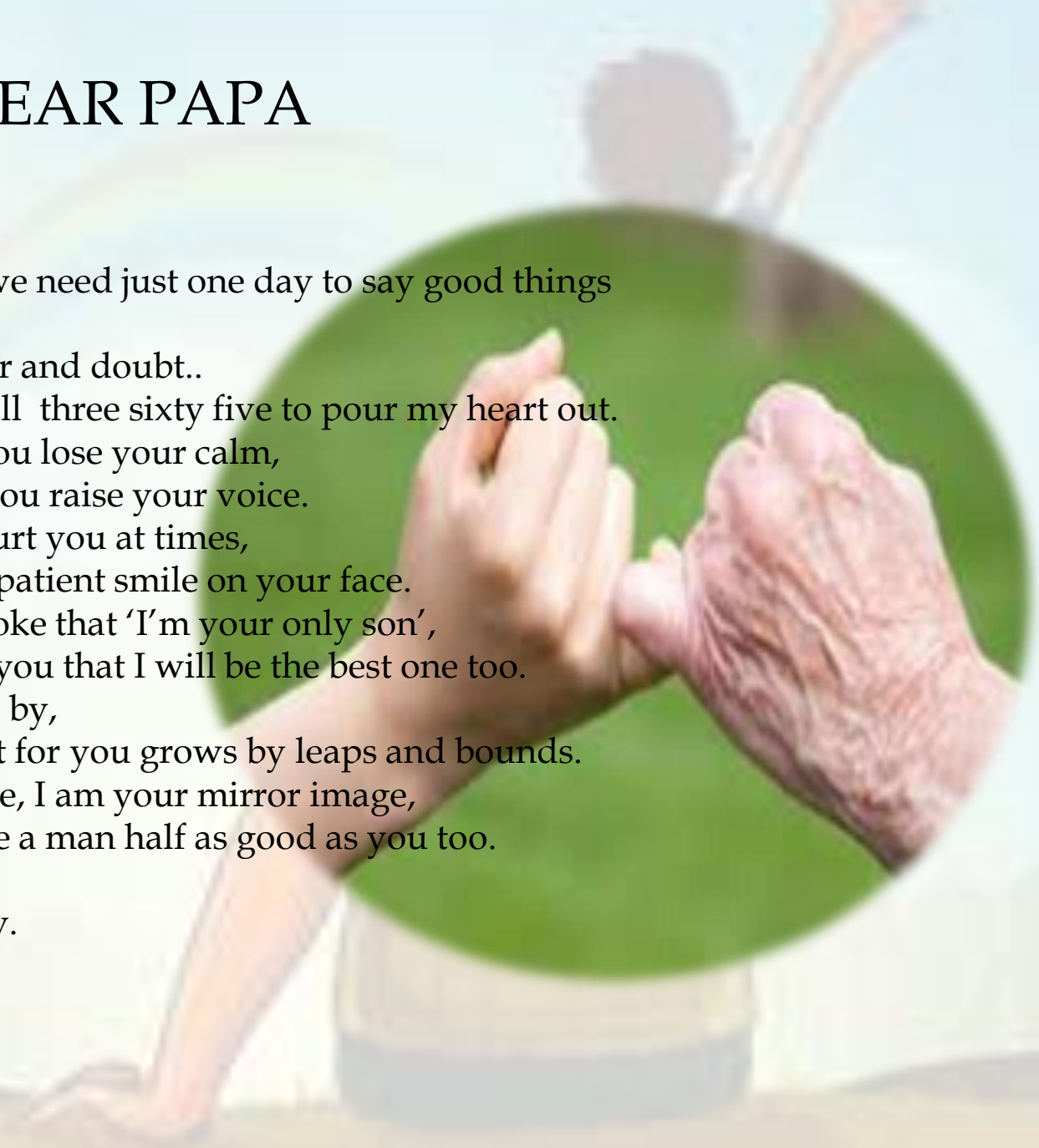
I hope that I become a man half as good as you too.

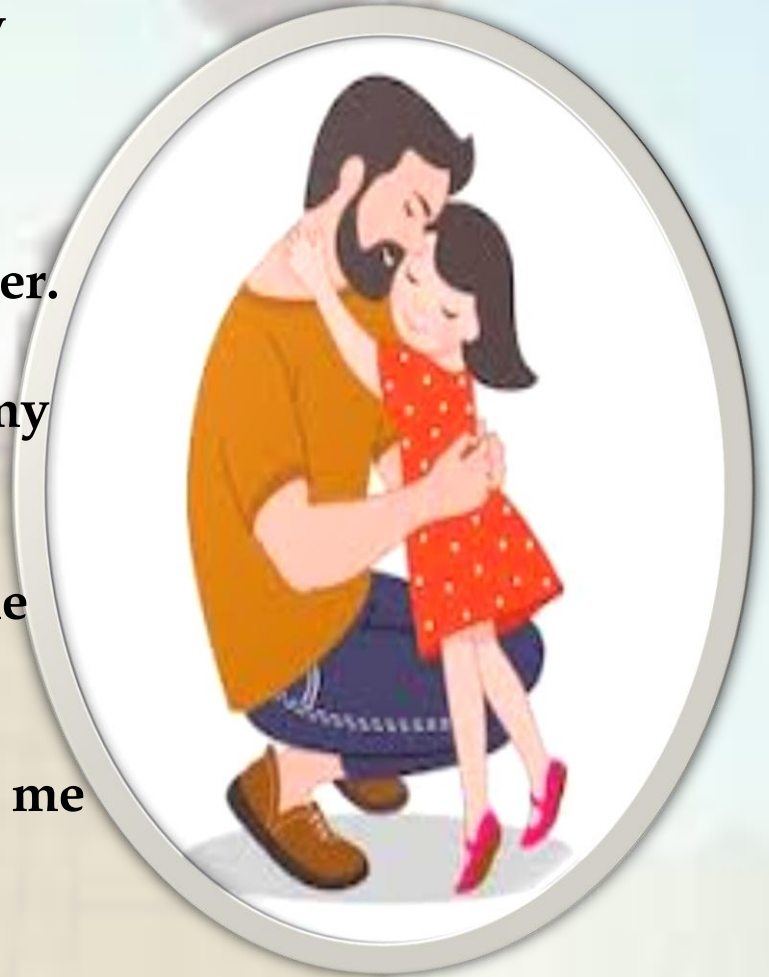

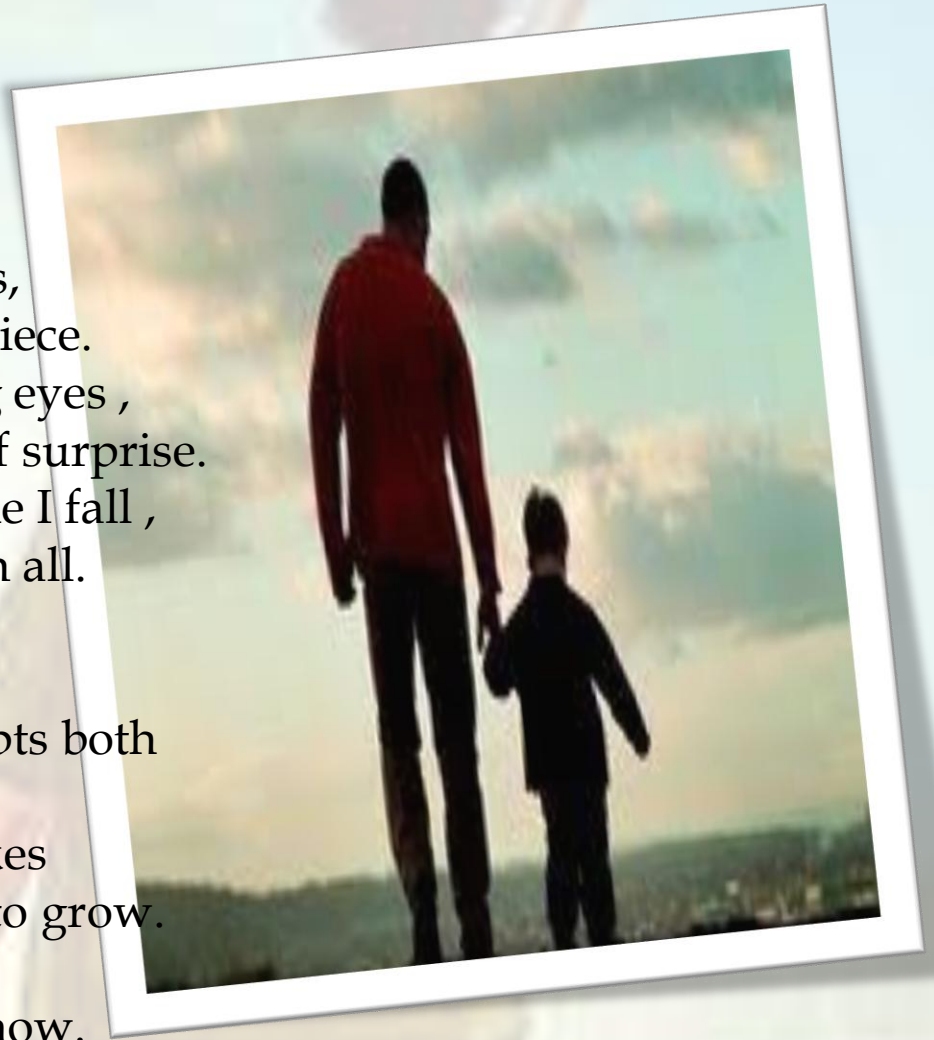
Father's Day

done it all.

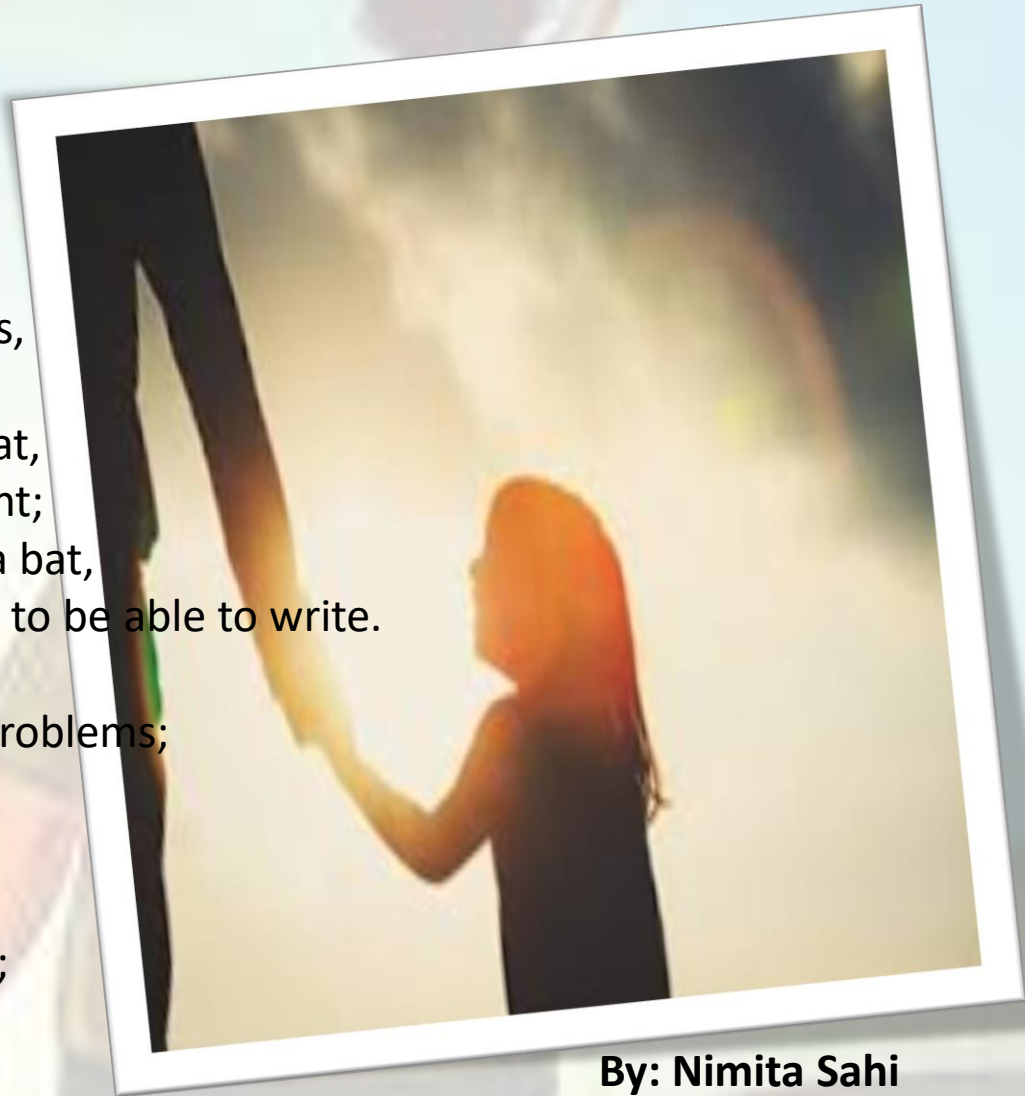
For the support he has given me, the trust he has shown

You had to leave, maybe some reasons you didn't want to speak.

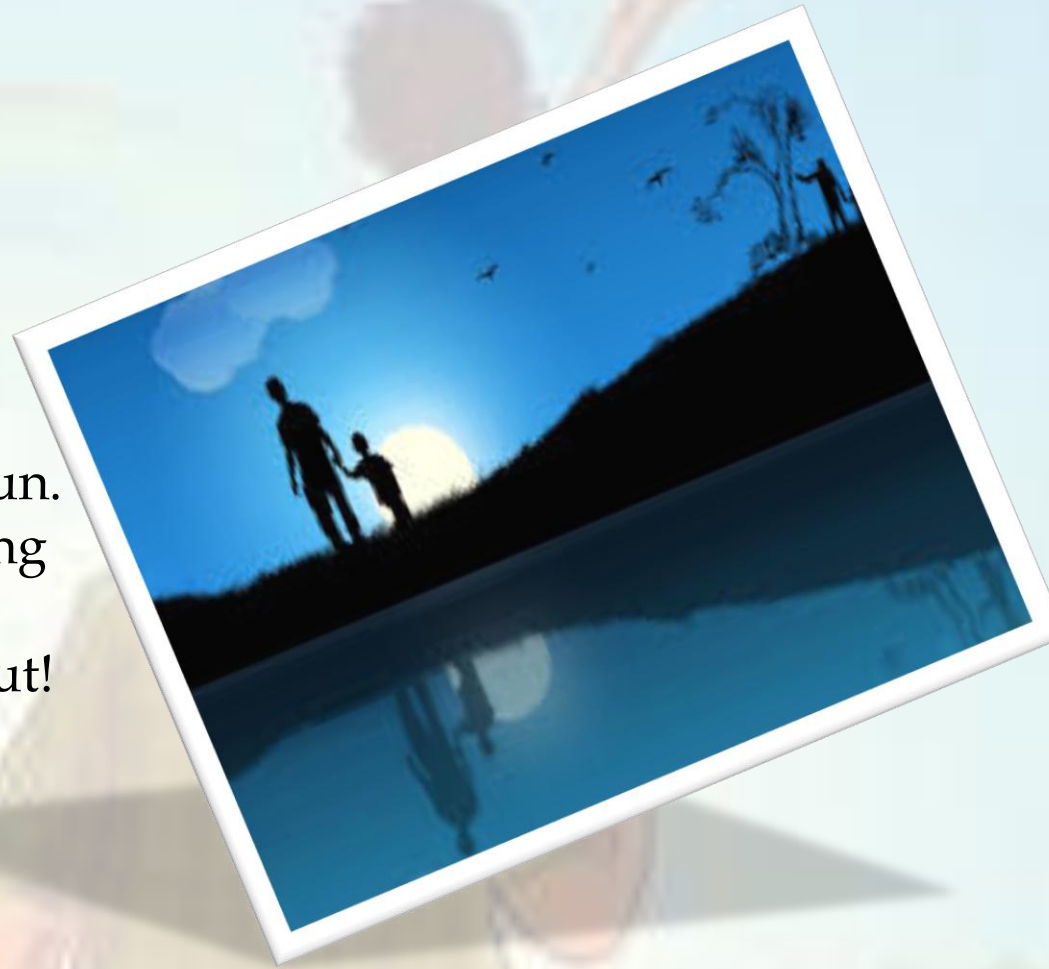
I learnt to love more than anything else,

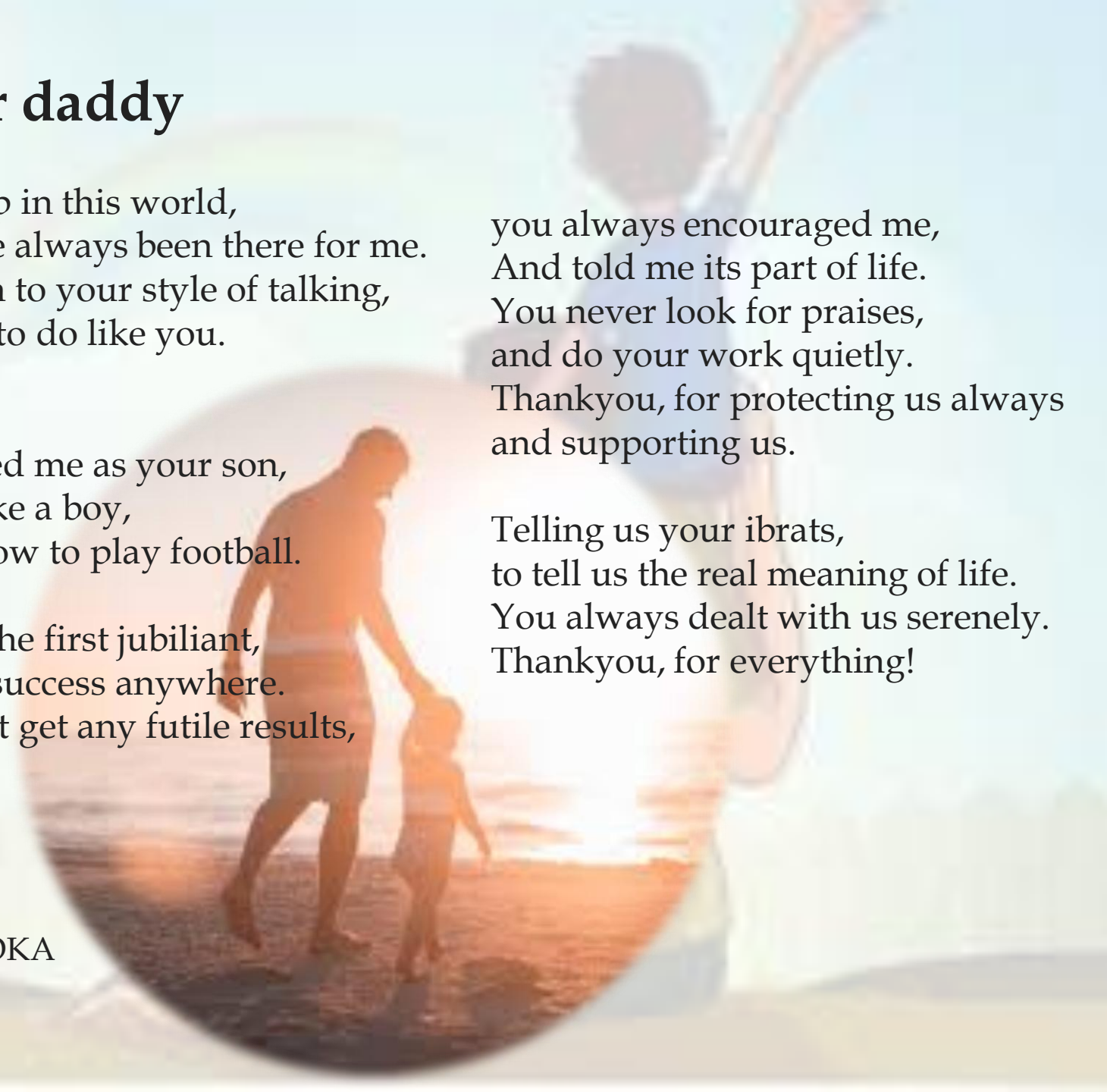



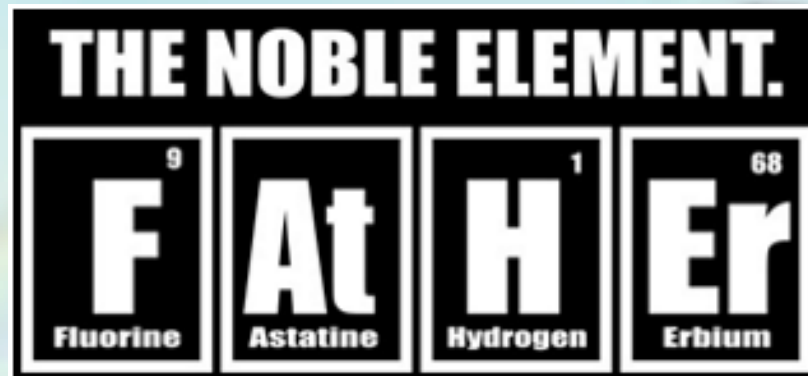






I just want to let you know
