Art & Craft

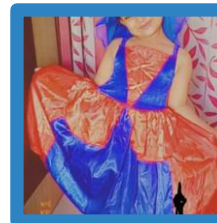
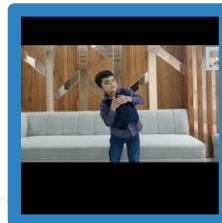
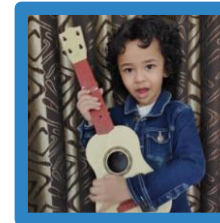
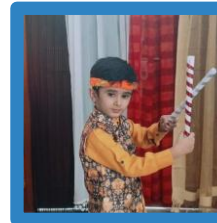
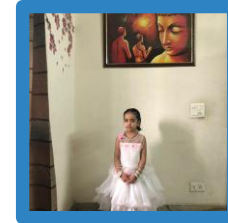

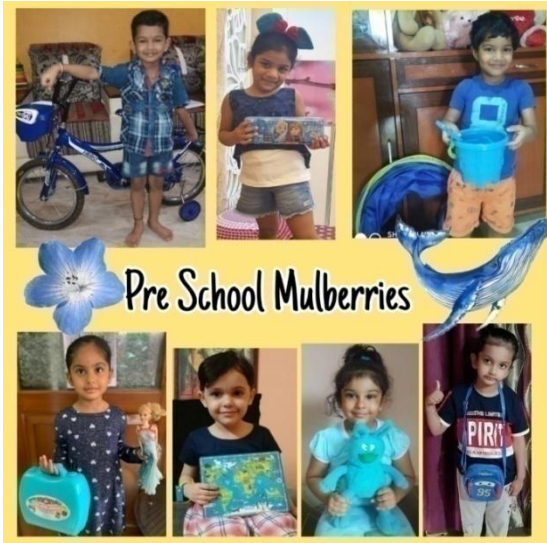
Circle Time

Even the parents had a great time as these online classes have given us the opportunity to share our joy and celebrate the festival together with them.



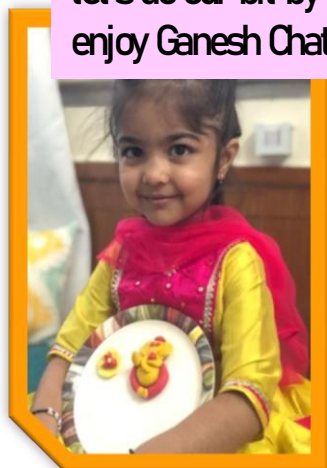
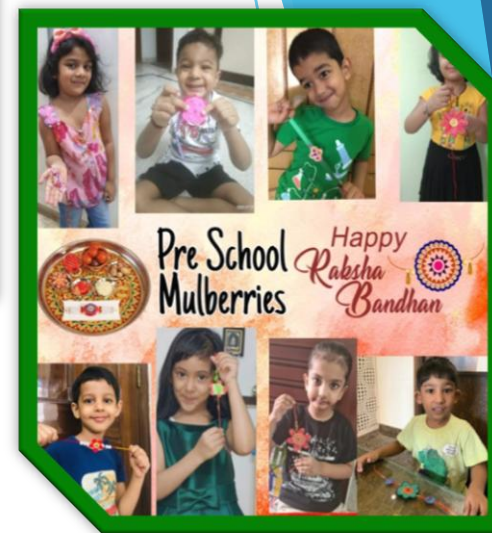


Celebrating Festivals...

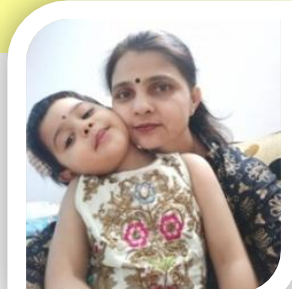
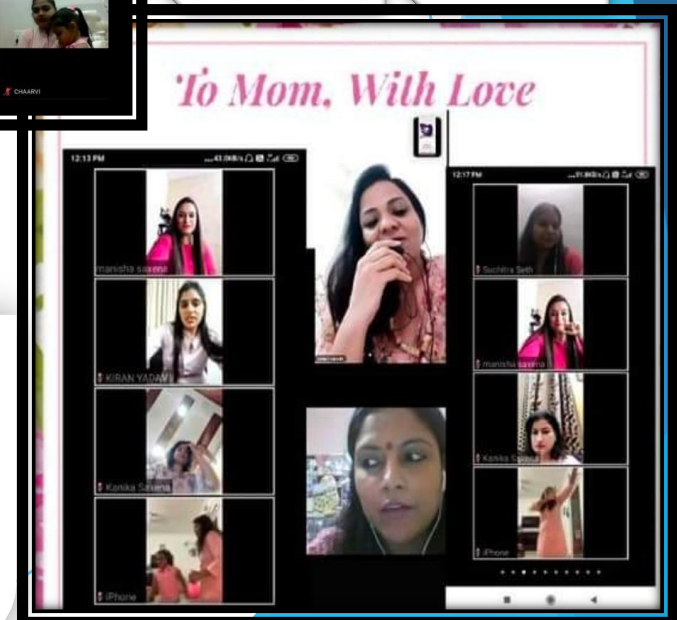
Special Celebrations...

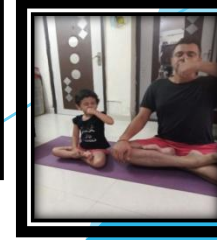
FATHERS' DAY

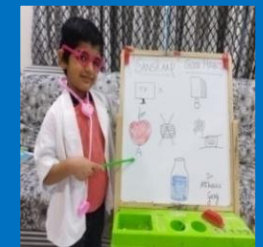


NATIONAL DOCTORS DAY

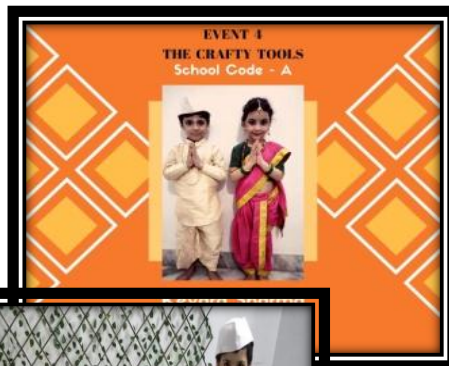

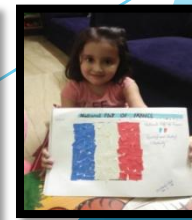
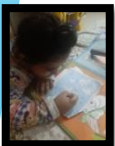
ISA

They were overwhelmed to serve the starters in artistic and aesthetic way. A fun filled activity with the collaboration of parents.



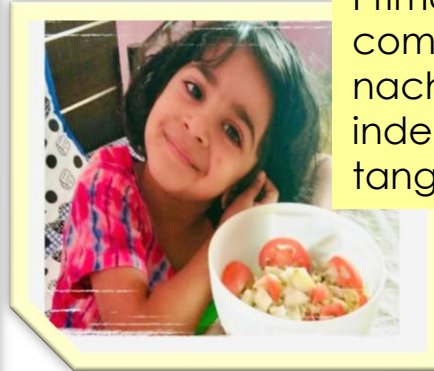

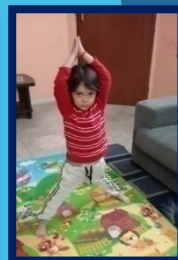
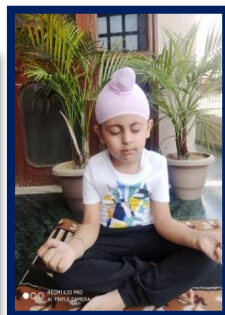
PHYSICAL FITNESS

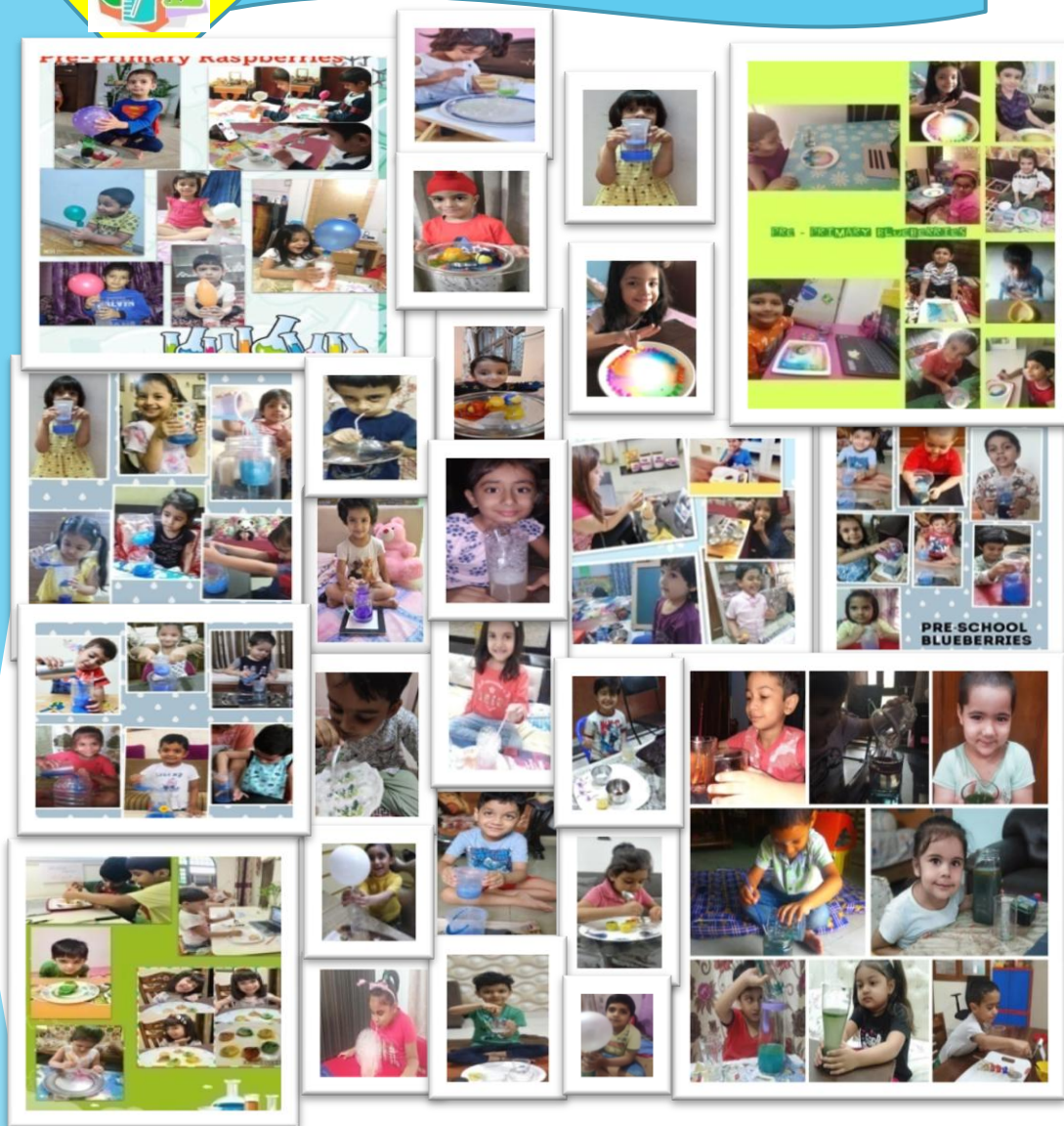

Story Time....

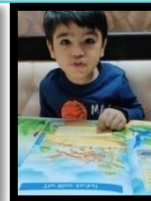
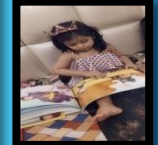
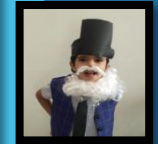

There were various activities that were taken up to make reading more enjoyable and to engage kids to be avid readers.

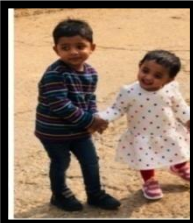




Monthly Activities

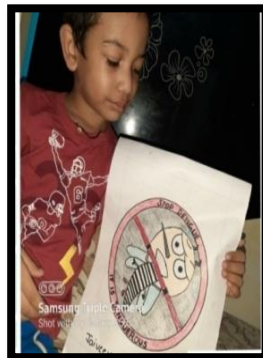




Awareness Campaigns...

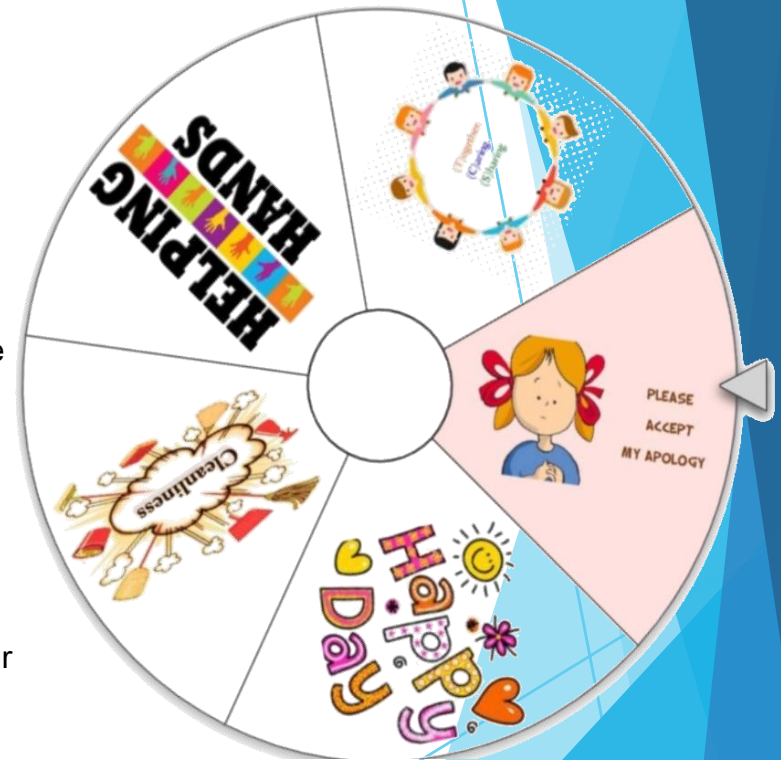
The day starts in Pre-Primary Mulberries with the energizing activities which will enhance listening skills, retention power and to express the learning.

Innovative Teaching...



" Creativity is a natural extension of enthusiasm"

Context: _Musical Water Glasses_ "A Melodious Science Experiment "

Henry Caldwell Cook emphasized on the importance of play way method and brought a new vision towards the teaching methodologies.

Children learn better by doing. Therefore, a very interesting sound activity was introduced to the Pre Primary children so that they can experience and understand the sound variations by placing water at different levels in glass jars.

Methodology: In this Science experiment, kids explored the intensity of the sound by turning glasses filled with water at different levels into musical instruments. Sound is created through vibrations. When things vibrate fast they produce sound of higher intensity, and vice a versa. With Musical Water Glasses Activity, children understood that when there is more water in the glass jar, the intensity of the sound produced is lower because the water has caused the glass to vibrate slower.

Response: Children really enjoyed experimenting and by listening they drew inferences on their own.

They were much happier to share their observations.

This activity enabled them to develop Observation Skills, Inter-personal Skills, Intra-personal Skills, Linguistic Skills, Musical Skills and above all learning through fun by catering to multiple sense organs.

- Sound is created through vibrations.
- Vibrations creates waves that travel through air.
- Water level effect the intensity of the sound.

Creative Corners.....

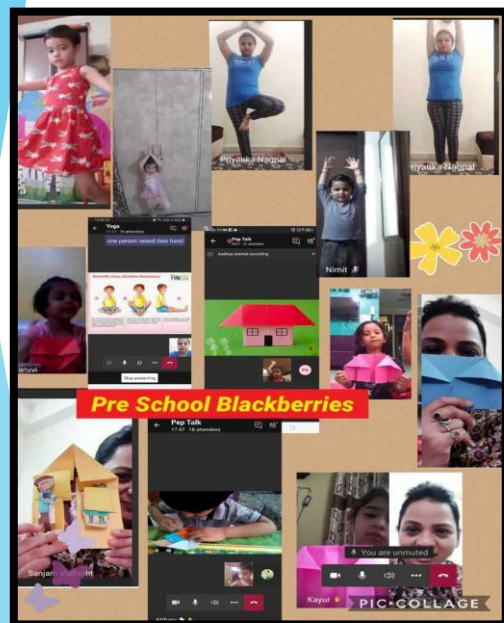
