Now, look at the given pictures and answer the following:

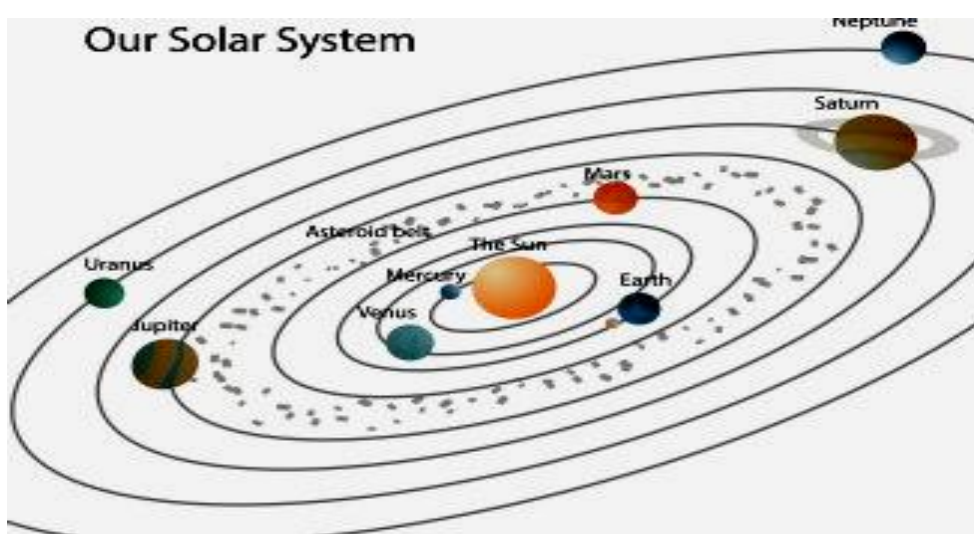

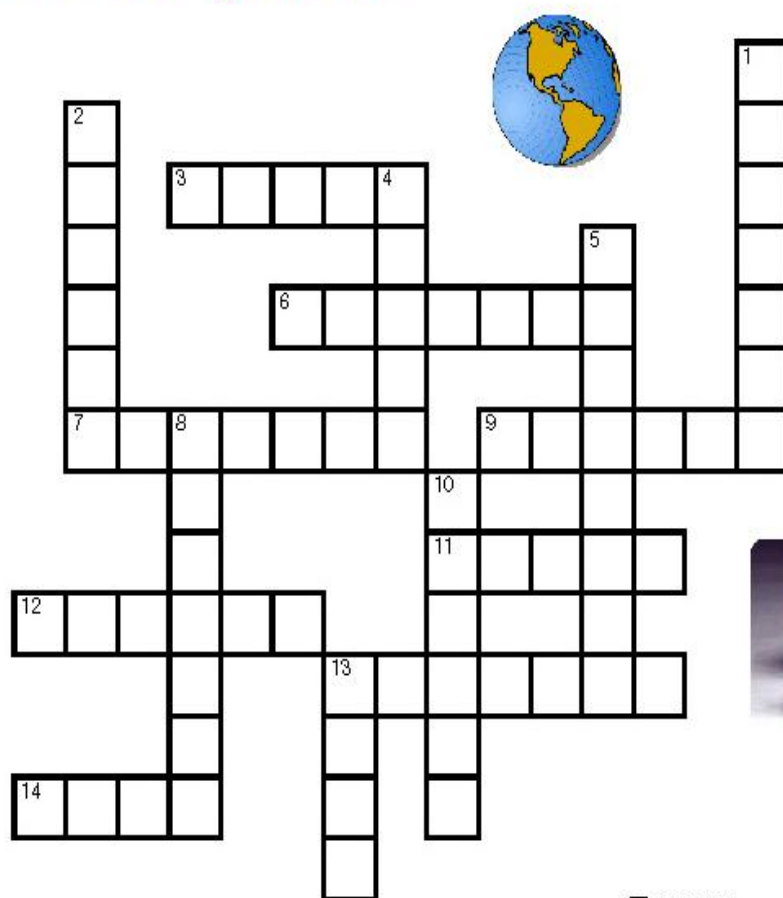
