1. Henceforth, all school messages will be shared through **entab CampusCare**, please download the **CampusCare Mobile App**, if not done so far on your iOS / Android device.
2. **Next PTM is scheduled on October 05, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Last entry for parents will be not later than 10:30 a.m.** All answer sheets (Classes III-XII) have been shown to your ward and the marks will be available on **CampusCare Website, url: svis.campuscare.info**. While more than 1600 parents have logged on to the CampusCare Website, we have noted with a little sadness, that 950 parents have not yet logged on to CampusCare. We are again enclosing the log in credentials advisory circular for these parents. **Please ensure becoming comfortable with the new url as the school has discontinued Shauryasoft and Uolo both.**
3. **Prevention of Vector Borne Diseases:**
Delhi is likely to face acute problem of Dengue, Malaria, Chikungunya, if we do not actively prevent mosquito breeding in & around our homes. Every Sunday, do check for any stagnation of water in any flower pot, indoor vases, fengshui plant pots, empty vessels, etc. Keep the overhead water tanks well covered. Check all the water storage every week. Dengue transmitting Aedes mosquito breeds in clean water and bites during day time, hence **make your child wear socks, full-sleeved shirts and full trousers during day time. Apply mosquito-repellent creams (preferably organic)** on exposed body parts. Keep sick children at home for quick recovery and preventing transmission.
4. **We would like to seek your help in checking over use of plastics and aluminum foil. Use cloth or jute bag for shopping. Our country needs all citizens to be proactive and responsible.**
