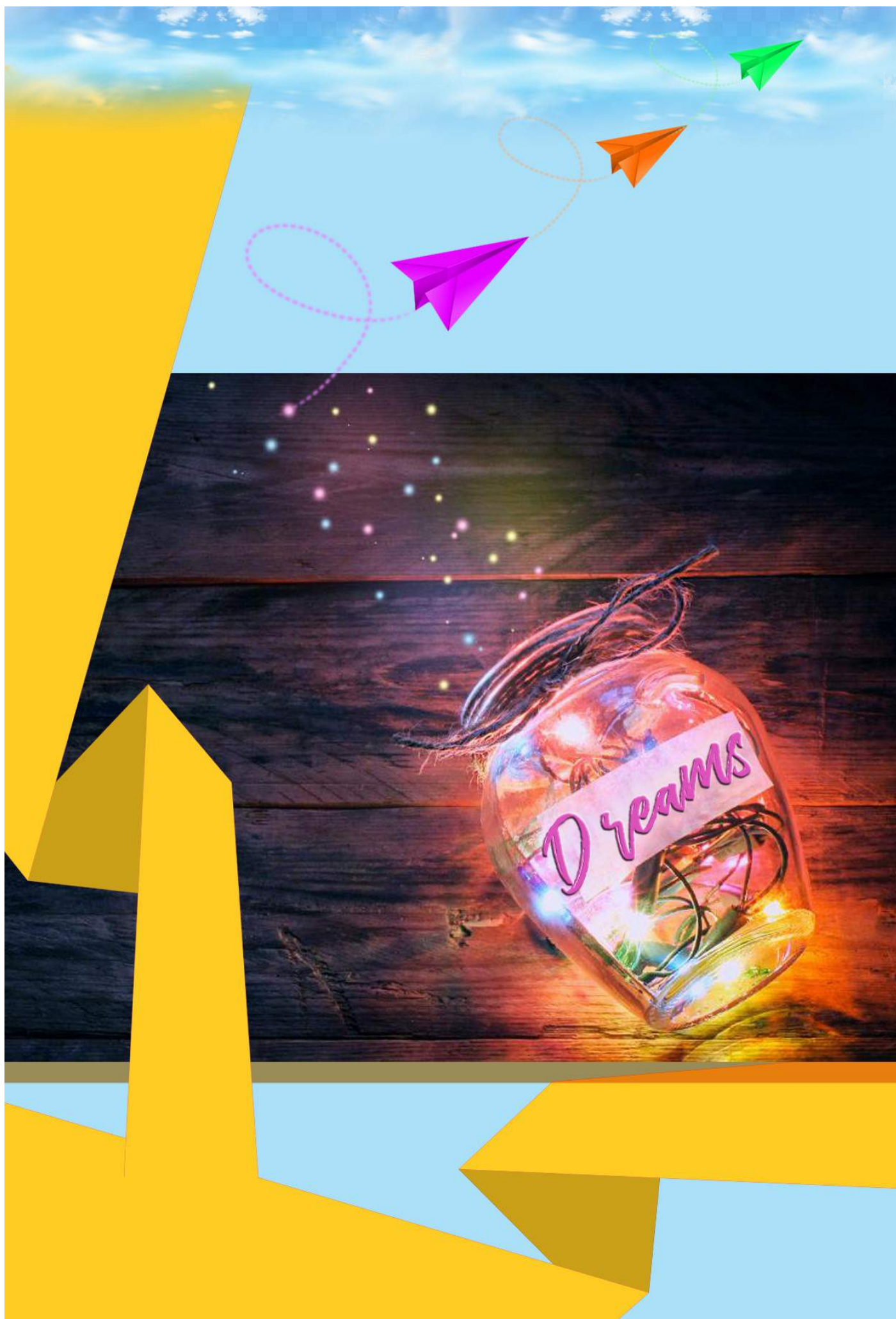

Thus, I have many goals but one that I wish to pursue is to be happy, healthy and enjoy my life to the fullest.

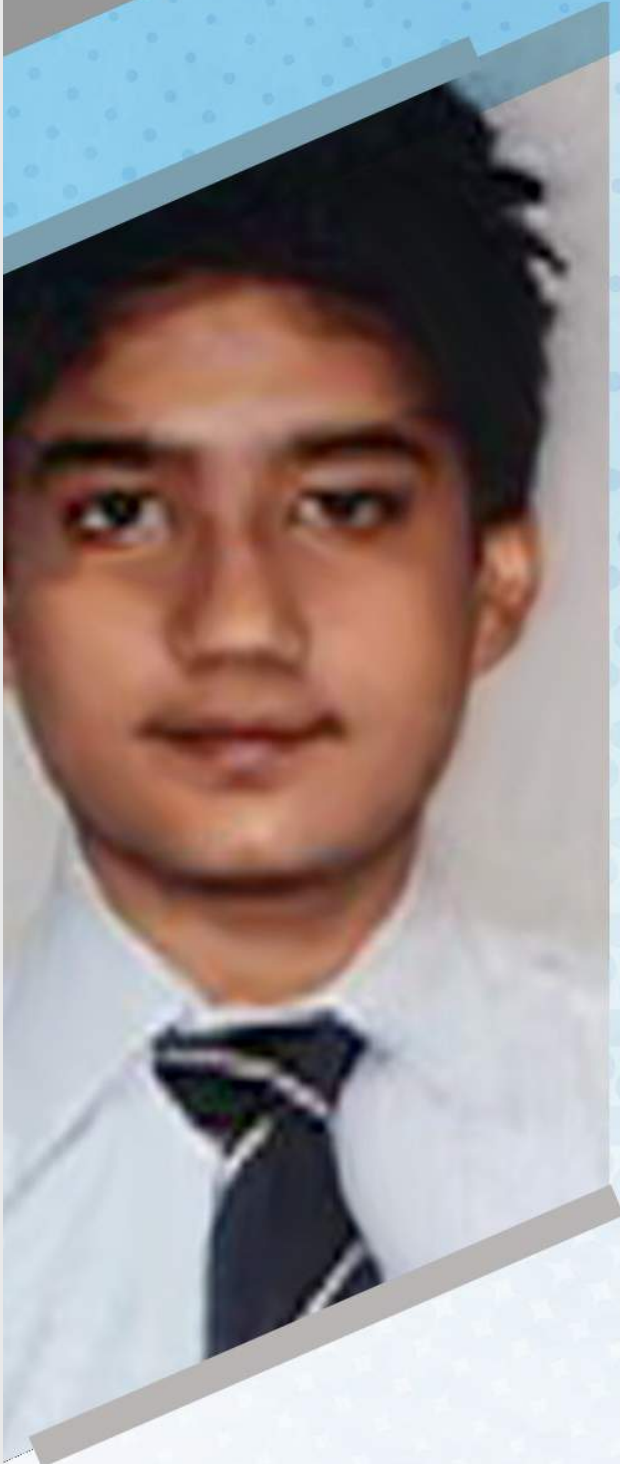

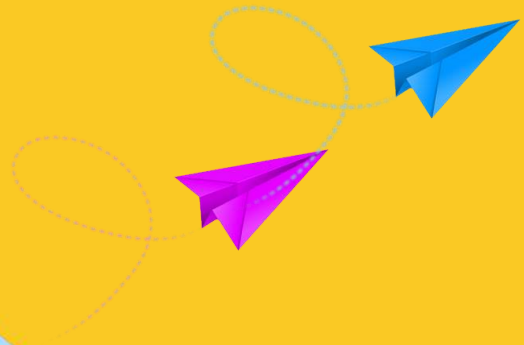
