4. Use of props, sound, music etc.

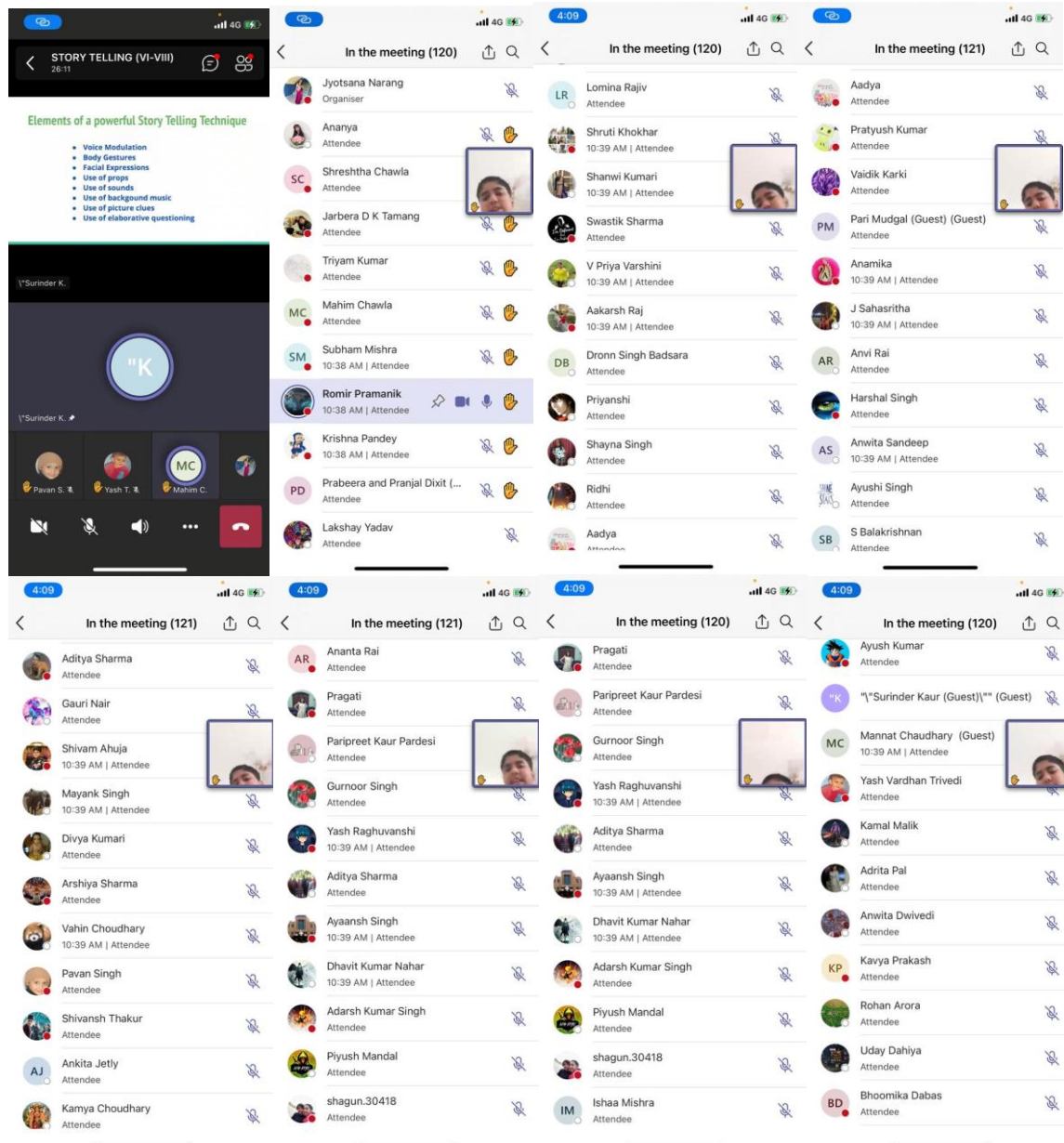

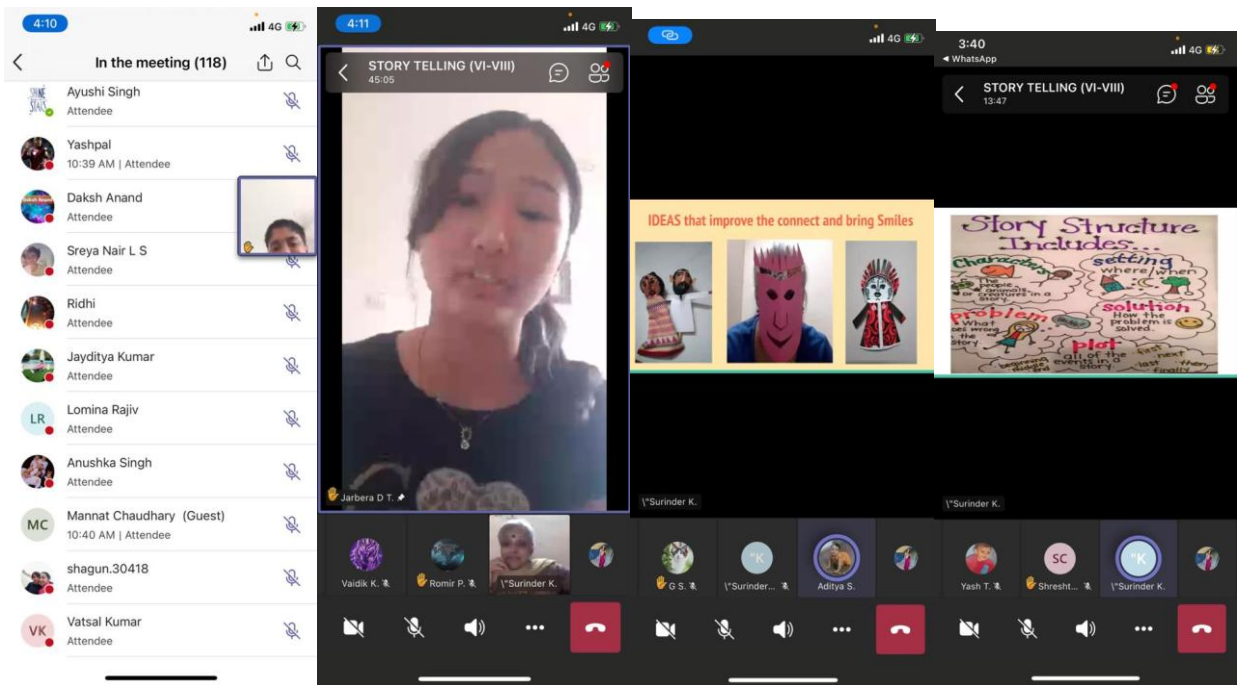
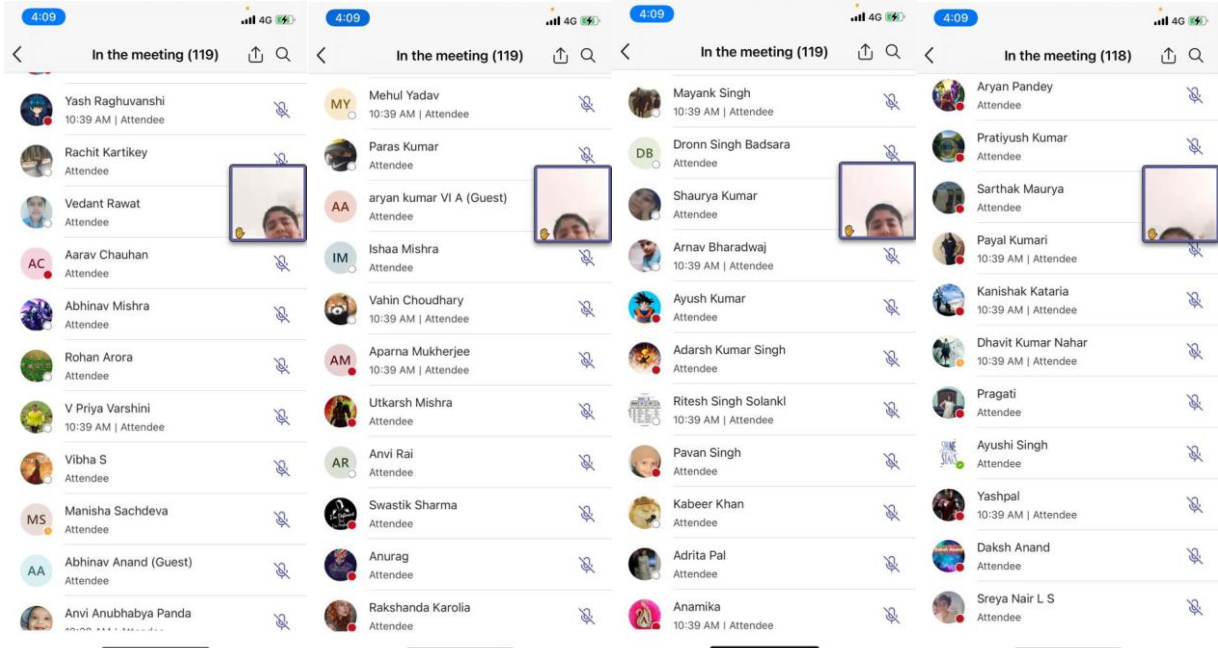
Following is the feedback received from different students of classes VI to VIII:
