

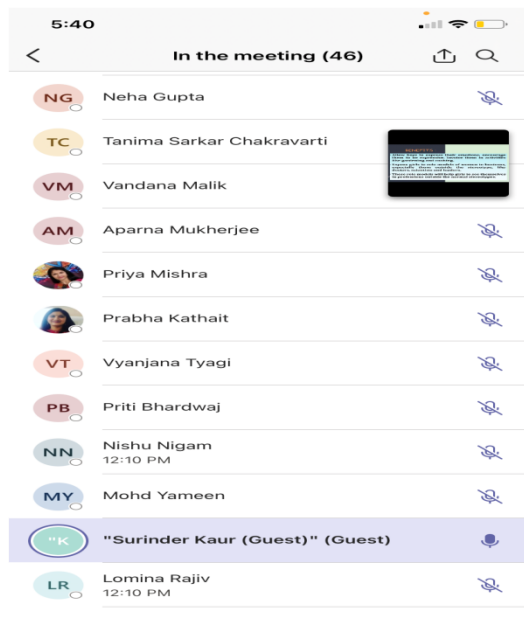
TEACHERS' WEBINAR ON GENDER SENSITIZATION

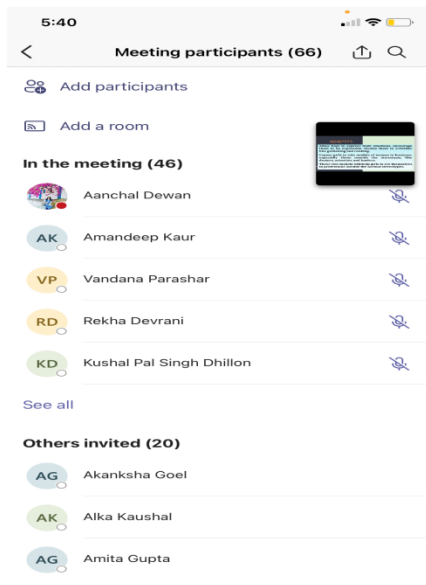
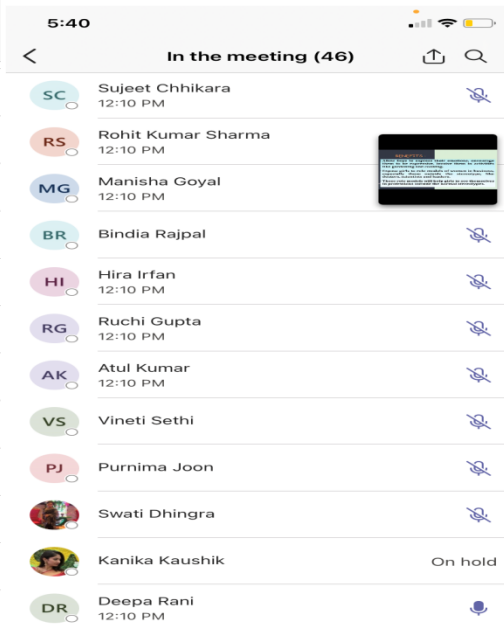
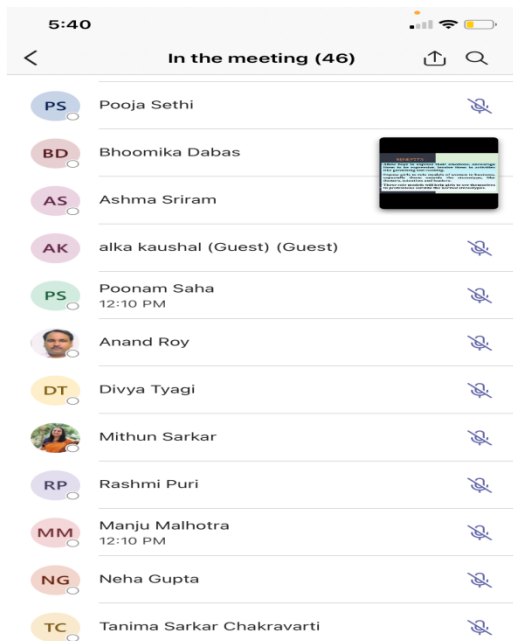
