

Azaadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav

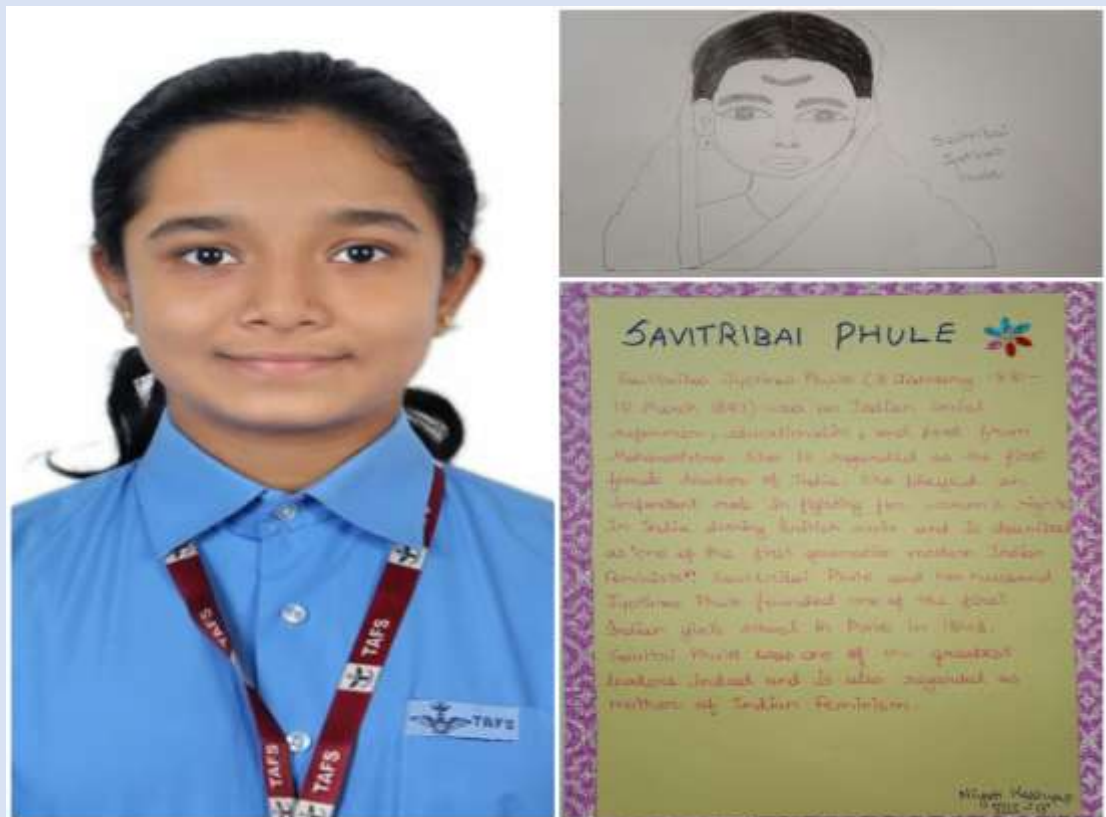
