THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith, worship, and of the individual units of society;

and to promote among them all FRATERNITY, removing the barriers of caste, colour, language and race, and to create a united and indivisible India where all its citizens shall live in harmony and brotherhood and secure the dignity and integrity of the Nation;

DO hereby adopt the Constitution for India and give to it the following PREAMBLE and CHAPTER I.

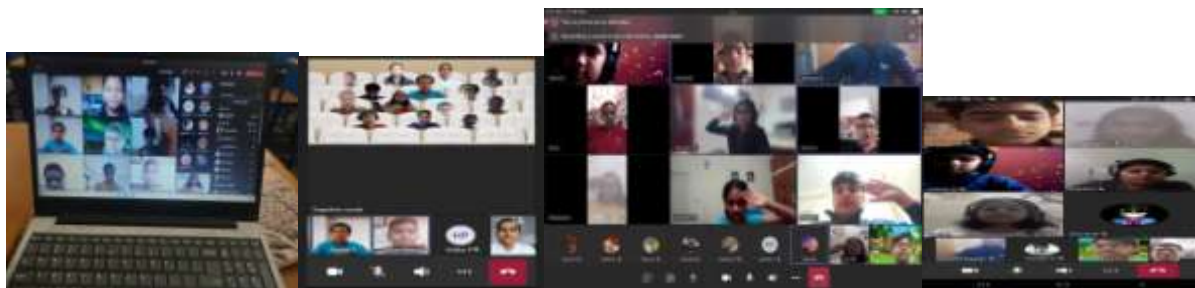
