NO BAG DAY

The various activities conducted in different subjects are listed below:

English- Radio Show (Interviewing a famous author/ poet)

In this activity, the students created their own radio show where the RJ interviewed a famous author/ poet about his life and works. The students sang beautiful songs in between to make the showmore interesting and give it the feel of a real radio show. Students created interesting names for their radio channel and the show.

Hindi- Tongue Twisters

For this activity, students were given a choice of tongue twisters to select, from a list of sentences, given by the teacher with a timelimit to recite their sentences. It was quite interesting for the students and they participated wholeheartedly in the same.

Maths- Shape Hunt

For the above activity, the students were taken to the playground. The entire class was divided into groups and with each group was given an interesting name. Riddles were provided to each group so that a particular shape may be recognised and thingscollected from the ground corresponding to the shape. This activity helped students to understand better the concept of basic geometrical ideas in nature.

Social Science- Roll Back, Tra La La! (Back to our beginning)

In this activity, the class was divided into groups of 8-10 students and the group enacted the life of early man as hunters, gatherers, the invention of fire and wheel. The students collected fallen leaves from the school ground and wove them into as headgears, hand bands, necklaces, etc.

Science- Protein and Starch Test

To conduct the above activity, the teacher collected the required material from the lab like: iodine solution, caustic soda, test tubes, beakers, etc. Thereafter food items brought by the students in their tiffin like bread, rice, cashew nut, paneer, curd, etc. were tested for starch and protein. The students fully enjoyed the activity and were very excited to get their share of the food tested .It gave them much delight to see the change in colours on performing the test.
